



I looked forward to getting back together with my friends in the band, so we could hang out together again," she said with a smile.

While the clarinet and the band are certainly her greatest emphasis, they are not the only interests Faith has. "I like sports also," she shared. "As a freshman I played basketball, and last year I played soccer. I did not develop the individual relationships with the other team members in sports like I have with the members of the band. I will not be involved in a sport this year because I am just going to commit my best effort to the band."

Another artistic release for Faith is drawing. She explained, "I like to draw, but art class has not been available for me to pursue it so far. I draw realistic things, like portraits of people and pictures of animals."

Academically, Faith is in the top 10 percent of her class, and that, along with her music, should lead to some scholarship offers as she looks toward college. "I am interested in a couple of schools right now. Stephen F. Austin, North Texas and A&M-Commerce are the ones I'm thinking about," she mentioned. Surprisingly, while music may be the means to the end, it is not what she plans to get her degree in at this point. "I am interested in studying psychology. I want to know more about how the mind works," she said.

Practicing her music is obviously a labor of love for Faith. During her freshman year, Faith was inspired by one of the senior members, Sarah Nicolaysen, another clarinet player. "She was always practicing," Faith remembered. "She helped with the overall band program, and she gave me some advice that helped with my solo when I went to contest." Long practice hours are part of Faith's routine today, and she is often still at the band hall practicing until 5:00 or 6:00 in the evening. "COVID limited some of our practice time last year, so we had to work harder during school hours."

Although the band is in the middle of marching season right now, Faith is looking forward to concert season in the spring. While she has scored all "ones" in solo contests previously, she continues to set goals to challenge herself. "I want to memorize a solo this year. Memorizing has not been a skill that I have mastered. I almost did it last year, but I 'chickened-out' before the contest. This year, I will do it!"



Another reason Faith looks forward to concert season is the more challenging music the concert band performs. While she enjoys the marches at half-time of the football games and at marching contest, she said, "I like the way the band sounds playing the concert music. We play more serious pieces."

Ennis High Band Director Gary Goodwin said that Faith is one of the best high school clarinet players in the state. She continues to set higher goals for herself and has the work ethic and determination to accomplish them. She concluded, "I want to say thanks to all my friends and family for supporting me and helping me reach my goals."

Faith Perez is an example of an Ennis youth who is sure to be an inspiring leader. Let's do all we can to support her and the other youth of our community. They are our future. NOW

Having just opened for business in January, Malcolm Glaspy is pleased with the way customers have responded to the new business. He also believes the local people appreciate the local ownership of the business. "We can't stress enough that the owners of Ren-Tools, David Maliska and Eric Toth, live here and are proud to have a business that is not part of a big corporation. 



Peanut Butter Potato Candy Be careful, it will be delicious.

1/4 cup mashed potatoes

- 2 Tbsp. milk
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1 pinch salt
- 1 16-oz. pkg. confectioners' sugar, plus additional for dusting

(Depending on humidity, more than 16 oz. may be needed for the dough.) 1/3 cup peanut butter

I. In a bowl, add the potatoes, milk, vanilla and salt; stir to combine.

2. Stir in the confectioners' sugar to make a dough. Chill for 1 hour.

3. Sprinkle confectioners' sugar on the

countertop; dust the rolling pin in the sugar. Spread the dough with a rolling pin until it is about as thin as a penny.

4. Spread the peanut butter on the dough.Roll the dough up like a jelly roll; chill.5. Cut into candy-size pieces.

Single Rise Whole Wheat Bread

2 cups wheat flour

- 2 Tbsp. dry yeast
- 2 1/2 cups warm water
- 4 cups whole wheat flour
- 3 tsp. salt
- 1/3 cup honey
- 1/3 cup vegetable oil
- Butter, melted, to taste

 Mix together the wheat flour, dry yeast and warm water in a bowl. Let set for about 30 minutes until frothy.
 Add the whole wheat flour, salt, honey

and vegetable oil.

3. Mix with a spoon until it pulls away from the bowl.

- 4. Knead about 15 minutes.
- **5.** Form the dough into two loaves; let it rise.
- 6. Bake for 30 minutes at 350 F.7. Brush the tops with melted butter when done.

Teriyaki Marinade

This is a simple, family favorite.

1 cup soy sauce
1/2 cup water
1/2 cup pineapple juice
1/3 cup brown sugar
1/4 cup vegetable oil
1 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
1 tsp. grated fresh ginger
1 tsp. garlic powder
1/2 tsp. onion powder

I. In a bowl, mix together all of the ingredients. It can be stored for days and may be used for beef, pork, chicken or vegetables.

Richest Banana Pudding

2 cups cold milk

- I 5-oz. pkg. instant vanilla or banana pudding mix
- 1 14-oz. can sweet condensed milk (Refrigerate until cold.)
- 1 Tbsp. vanilla extract
- 1 14-oz. tub Cool Whip, slightly thawed
- 1 16-oz. box vanilla wafers, sliced
- 14 bananas (Yes, 14.)

 In a bowl, beat the milk and pudding mix until thick.
 Blend in the condensed milk and vanilla extract; fold in the Cool Whip.

1 15-oz. can diced tomatoes, drained
1 4-oz. can diced green chilis
4 poblano peppers, halved
1/2 cup mozzarella cheese, grated

I. In a skillet, fry the beef, chorizo and rice together.

3. Stuff the pepper halves with the cooked mixture. Add the cheese on top. Cook in a 350 F oven until the cheese is browned.

Remember, biscuits are about technique. Use cold ingredients, and do not overmix or overwork the dough.



- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 Tbsp. baking powder
- 1 stick cold butter
- l tsp. salt
- I cup buttermilk

 In a bowl, mix together all the ingredients just until incorporated. It will seem dry.
 Roll out the dough; cut into rounds. (Do not twist the cutter when cutting the dough.)
 Place the rounds on a baking tin. (Make sure they are touching.)
 Bake for 10 minutes at 500 F.

Fajita Rub

- 1/4 cup paprika
- 3 Tbsp. sea salt
- 2 Tbsp. chili powder 3 Tbsp. black pepper
- 2 Tbsp. garlic powder
- 1 1/2 Tbsp. white sugar
- 1 Tbsp. dried cilantro
- $1 \frac{1}{2}$ tsp. ground cumin

I. Combine all ingredients together and mix them all up. (It will keep in the refrigerator for months.)

2. Just rub on the meat of your choice before grilling.

3. You can moisten the meat and rub it in as a paste, if desired.

No-bake Oatmeal Cookies

This is my mom's recipe. Serve with love and a cold glass of milk. My favorite.

- 2 cups white sugar
- 1/4 cup cocoa
- 1/2 cup oleo butter
- 1/2 cup water
- I cup peanut butter
- l tsp. vanilla
- 3 cups quick oatmeal

I. In a saucepan, boil the sugar, cocoa, oleo and water for 1 minute.

- 2. Add the peanut butter and vanilla; beat well.
- 3. Add the oatmeal; beat well again.

4. Drop the mixture by teaspoonfuls onto waxed paper. Let cool before serving.






