# TWO UNIFORMS, 2 ONE MISSIO

Some people don't have to worry about what they will wear to work tomorrow, but at the end of the day, William Grauzer wears the Texas Tan in his role as a Texas Department of Public Safety Highway Patrol trooper assigned to Navarro County and wears U.S. Army camouflage when he's in his role as an Army drill sergeant. "Both jobs provide protection and service to Texans, Texas visitors and all Americans," he said. "I'm proud to serve."

Similarities in the two jobs abound. "I get to positively motivate, educate and interact with people from different areas." Trooper Grauzer said, "Every experience is a learning opportunity, and I go to places I never thought I would go. Both jobs have a chain of command with rules and regulations to follow. I have to multitask, be proactive and physically and mentally ready for the unexpected."

A DPS trooper for nine years, he investigates vehicular crashes and works traffic enforcement and criminal investigations anywhere in Texas. Trooper Grauzer also serves as DPS' North Texas Region law enforcement physical fitness specialist, traveling throughout the region helping officers stay mentally and physically fit through proper nutrition and exercise. "I get to communicate with other troopers, find helpful resources and make physical fitness a blast," he explained. In addition to his duties as a physical fitness specialist, he also writes, edits and publishes a monthly fitness newsletter.

A native of Michigan who has called Texas home since 1979, Grauzer started his military career in the U.S. Navy in 1988. He served on the USS *Sacramento*, USS *Abraham Lincoln* and USS *Constellation* and is a veteran of Desert Storm and Operation Iraqi Freedom. During his Navy career, he took advantage of educational opportunities, earning his B.A. degree from Fort Hays State University in Kansas and a master's degree from Touro University (now Trident University) in Cypress, California.

After leaving full-time service in the Navy, he transferred to the U.S. Army Reserve and joined Texas DPS. "One of my greatest honors was being selected to attend drill sergeant school," he recalled. "As a drill sergeant, I motivate both positively and negatively as necessary to assist troops in preparing for war and other assignments we might be called to do at any time. It includes a lot of handson training, helping military candidates become prepared, but like everything else in life, documentation and paperwork also are required. Both being a drill sergeant and trooper require being self-motivated." His Army training is conducted at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, with monthly military drills in Grand Prairie, Texas.

Staying safe and alert always and missing important family time and events are challenges in both jobs. Trooper Grauzer cited several unique DPS challenges — working fatal collisions, doing the job in varying weather and working during holidays. "It's very important that Texas drivers remember that it is the law to move over or slow down to at least 20 mph under the posted speed limit if unable to move over when they see law enforcement or emergency responder vehicles with their lights on, sitting on the side of the road," he noted. "Army challenges include the unknown also, since we're reactive to world events. I have to balance my time in the military with my job in DPS."

Performing his two jobs well takes faith, along with a flexible and supportive family: wife, Elizabeth; daughter, Philadelphia; and son, Ezekiel, who currently resides out of state. "When I'm not wearing a uniform, my family gets my full attention," Trooper Grauzer said.

"My wife and I enjoyed our first date at a theme park and enjoy theme parks to this day. We enjoy any family time we






are afforded and absolutely love going on cruises together! We are currently preparing for a family cruise in February." He feels at home in Corsicana. "We bought a home in the country a few years ago, and we love it. Faith, family and service are what keeps our family grounded."

His advice to young men and women who wish to serve in either job is become and stay physically fit for duty. "Don't wait for the recruiter to get you there. Also, study history," he stated. "Service in the military is good prior experience in the DPS hiring process but isn't required. If you're interested in either job, talk to a recruiter. A DPS recruiter can also arrange a ride-along experience."

Awards have come his way through his DPS and military service. Both of his uniforms are decorated with appropriate service ribbons earned in the military and DPS. Trooper Grauzer earned a Lifesaving Award in 2015 for having rendered first aid until the Corsicana Fire Department and EMTs arrived after he responded to a Corsicana home fire. He's received four DPS commander awards for leadership, physical fitness, motivation and attitude and crash investigation. The Kiwanis Club also voted him the 2015 Trooper of the Year. The Army proudly awarded Sgt. Grauzer the 2017 Regional Drill Sergeant of the Year honors. He holds both a peace officer and a drill sergeant certification.

"The people I work with in the DPS are what I enjoy most about my job as a trooper. It's such an honor to serve the people of this great state by being a trooper and getting to carry on the DPS heritage and wear the Texas Tan uniform," Trooper Grauzer stated. "I keep learning and training. It's such a pleasure knowing I can help protect the rights and lives of Texans and visitors to this great state. My service in the DPS and the military is more than a career for me."




Shouts of welcome are interspersed into Caren Anthony's drill sergeant-like orders and cheerleader-like enthusiastic smiles and moves, as she welcomes a few latecomers to the exercise class at the Corsicana Senior Citizens Center. Some participants need canes, walkers or wheelchairs for mobility, but they are all there for cognitive, physical and voice exercise, and most of all, perhaps, the camaraderie and fun. "My students are the best!" Caren stated. "I go home excited every day because I see the progress they make as they toss away canes and walkers."

Designed specifically for people with Parkinson's, multiple sclerosis, strokes, other neurodegenerative diseases, traumatic brain injuries and balance issues, Caren's class follows the tenets of GZ Sobol's Parkinson's Network Foundations Class, a type of Parkinson's boot camp started in 2012 by Gary Sobol, who was diagnosed with the disease in 2008.

After meeting Gary at a conference, Caren, a professional health care provider, wanted to know more. She accomplished her goal of training and becoming certified in the program when her employer, Cedar Lake Home Health and Hospice, agreed to underwrite her training and allow her to conduct weekly classes in addition to her duties as a volunteer coordinator at the company's nursing



home. In 2016, Caren began the classes in Gun Barrel City, followed by Corsicana, Athens and Malakoff. "We have a Facebook page, GZ Sobol's Parkinson's Network: Team Texas," Caren said.

The Corsicana class is held every Tuesday and Thursday at 9:30 a.m. "We have an average of about 20 students each class," Caren explained. "We make it fun, so people will enjoy class and come back. It takes several sessions for people to realize a difference in their quality of life. The hands-in-the-air cheers, shouted between each exercise, helps voices and lungs grow stronger." Best of all, classes are free.

With much progress gained, student Brad Haynie is a regular attendee. Unusual lethargy and dexterity problems with his left hand led to his Parkinson's diagnosis. "My neurologist said I needed to be on meds and exercise," Brad recalled. "My feet shuffled when I first came to this class, but they don't anymore. The difference between this exercise class and others are the smiles and fun we have."

Wanda Luedecke's goal in attending is to "get ahead of aging." "I think this class prepares us for what's coming," she stated. A musician and retired Corsicana ISD music teacher, she was finding it increasingly difficult to play her oboe and write. "I thought my playing days were over, but with exercise and meds, I'm back to doing both," Wanda said proudly.

While both Brad and Wanda are Corsicana natives, it took fellow student Rita Johnson, a Chicago native, "50 years to get here." Word-of-mouth has been the way most students learn of the class,





but Rita saw a banner outside the senior center promoting the then-new class, "I'd always had balance issues and thought this class would help," she said. "I know there are others needing to come and give it a try. We're very casual and laid-back."

Inspiration toward movement and achievement of goals has run both ways. Caren suffered two aneurisms after teaching a morning class. Her son, Cade, who's also a local EMT, was contacted. After being taken by helicopter to Dallas, Caren underwent open-heart surgery. "The class continued without me while I recovered and then became my physical therapy, helping me come back," Caren said.

"I give God the glory for keeping Caren here," Wanda stated.

With the average onset age of Parkinson's at 56, most students are senior citizens, but the class is open to all ages. However, Caren also is considering starting an evening class for younger students who still work. "No equipment or special clothing is needed, but those using walkers or wheelchairs must be accompanied by a caregiver," Caren said. Doing class exercises at home is encouraged, as are other forms of exercise that keep students moving, as long as there are at least two people present.

The class thanks Fred Biltz, center director, and the city of Corsicana for help in making the class possible. Class members cited Corsicana's "just right size" and the arts and volunteer opportunities as pluses. Brad concluded, "I like Corsicana and this class. There are hugs, laughter and tears. We're a family." NOW

Sam agreed, "We get to meet and help friendly people."





I cup apple juice
2 tsp. vinegar
1/3 cup liquid smoke
Lawry's Seasoning Salt, to taste
Granulated garlic, to taste

### Black pepper, to taste Hickory chips (soaked in water and drained)

1/2 cup chili powder

1 lb. ground chuck

I pkg. smoked sausage

- **1.** Combine pinto beans, Ro-Tel tomatoes and chili powder in a large saucepan.
- **2.** Brown and drain ground chuck; add to the saucepan.
- **3.** Slice the smoked sausage into 1/2-inch rounds; add to the saucepan.
- **4.** Stir well; cook on medium heat for 30-45 minutes.

### **Loaded Baked Potato Casserole**

Makes 6-8 servings.

5 large baking potatoes

I cup real bacon bits

1 cup sour cream

1/2 stick unsalted butter

1 cup Velveeta cheese, cubed

2 cups sharp cheddar cheese, shredded (divided use)

1/2 cup evaporated milk

1/2 Tbsp. granulated garlic

1/2 cup chives

Salt and pepper, to taste

- **I.** Peel and cut baking potatoes into medium-size chunks. Parboil the potato chunks in a large saucepan; drain off any excess water.
- **2.** Add bacon bits, sour cream, butter, Velveeta cheese, I cup sharp cheddar cheese, evaporated milk, garlic, chives and salt and pepper to the potatoes. Mix well; pour mixture into a greased baking dish.
- **3.** Top with remaining cheese; bake for 30 minutes at 350 F.

### **Easy Breezy Coconut Cake**

Makes a 10-inch, 2-layer cake. Serves 8-10.

#### Cake:

- 2 boxes Duncan Hines White Cake Mix (divided use)
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup milk
- 1 Tbsp. vanilla
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil

### Icing:

- I 8-oz. jar marshmallow creme I medium tub Cool Whip Coconut, shredded, to taste I Tbsp. vanilla
- **1.** For cake: In a large mixing bowl, mix together all of the cake ingredients, reserving 1/2 cup of the cake mix for flouring the cake pans. Beat on high for 4-5 minutes.
- **2.** Grease and flour 2 10-inch cake pans using the reserved cake mix as the flour. Pour batter into prepared pans. Bake at 325 F until cake springs back when lightly touched, about 20 minutes. Let cool.
- **3.** *For icing*: Combine all icing ingredients. Frost cooled layers.

### Mississippi Mud Pie

Makes 8 servings.

#### Pie:

1 cup unsalted butter

4 eggs







1 cup pecan pieces I cup coconut, shredded 2 cups granulated sugar 1 1/2 cups sifted all-purpose flour 1/3 cups cocoa

1 jar marshmallow creme

Icing:

1/2 cup butter, softened 2 cups powdered sugar 1/3 cup cocoa 1/2 cup milk 1 Tbsp. vanilla

1. For pie: Melt butter; add melted butter and next 6 ingredients to a mixing bowl. Mix well; pour into a greased baking pan.

- 2. Bake at 325 F for 20 minutes. While still hot from the oven, spread top with marshmallow creme. Let cool.
- 3. For icing: Thoroughly combine all ingredients. When pie is cool, frost with the icing.

### Collard Greens and Ham Hocks

Makes 4-6 servings.

2 large smoked ham hocks I cube chicken bouillon 3-4 bunches collard greens 2 Tbsp. bacon drippings I tsp. red pepper flakes Salt and pepper, to taste

- 1. Boil ham hocks and chicken bouillon cube for 1 hour in a large saucepan.
- 2. Reduce heat. Wash greens; add them to the saucepan.
- 3. Add bacon drippings, red pepper flakes, salt and pepper; cook until tender.

#### Christmas Punch

Makes about 20 servings.

4 cups cranberry juice

2 32-oz. cans pineapple juice

1 cup ReaLemon juice

2 cups granulated sugar

3 cups water

12-oz. frozen strawberries (optional)

- 2 2-liter bottles of Canada Dry Ginger Ale
- 1. Combine all ingredients, except the ginger ale, and refrigerate. Just before serving, add the ginger ale.
