

EDITOR'S NOTE


Mansfield Family...

LaKeisha Glover's 8-year-old self reasoned while riding through the streets of New Orleans. When she saw people squatting on the sidewalks and roads, she couldn't comprehend why they didn't have a place to live or food to eat. She said, "I thought, There must be something I can do!" As she continued to notice this year after year, her mind roamed because she needed to create a solution.

Her church conducted various outreaches in the community. The members regularly set up food pick-ups for the needy. LaKeisha said, "I enjoyed helping. However, I remember asking my parents, 'How could we do more?' I repeatedly asked my dad, 'What can we do?' Each time I saw someone in need, ideas and solutions flooded my brain. Even as I got older and became a trained vocal professional, I believed I was going to get a recording contract and purchase a hotel to serve those less fortunate. That hasn't happened yet, but my desire to help people never went away."

In 2019, LaKeisha began developing the nonprofit, Mercy Street Kitchen. It took a while to set up this charity, but that didn't stop her from starting. "My husband is literally my biggest cheerleader," she mentioned. "He never questioned or doubted. He supported me every step of the way. I couldn't have done any of this without him. We simply moved forward and researched locations of the homeless and showed up with bags of goodies, which included snacks, water,

hot hands, deodorant, gloves, etc. This nonprofit's unofficial first event started with the participation of my husband, Wilbert Glover Jr. and our four children, Issachar, Leah, Elizabeth and Andrew. Our children truly love to serve because they have been serving their whole lives. While doing what we felt led to do, another family showed up with cooked food to distribute to the people in the area. What a blessing!"

While finalizing the steps for the nonprofit, they planned a big opening event to introduce Mercy Street Kitchen. Then, the pandemic hit, and the plans had to be adjusted. "Wearing gloves wasn't new," she said, "but the masks and spaces between individuals changed things. However, we made the necessary efforts to assist as many people as we could. We modified and created more Mercy bags to hand out. When we ran errands, we shared the items with those in need.

Eventually, we encountered a couple who was living in an abandoned barn. The lady said, 'I used to live in Frisco and have children, but when my husband went to jail, we lost everything.' As she continued to talk, she shared how thankful she was with the few possessions she had. She recalled, 'Someone comes by to bring us food every day.' I allowed her to talk because it seemed like she simply needed to talk to someone. There are a variety of homeless stories. Some people like living on the streets because they find four walls as confining.

"Recently, we were asked to supply bottles of detergent for children in foster care currently living as homeless



throughout the DFW area. They simply wanted to wash their clothes." The sweet volunteers and donors provided 200 bottles for these neighbors in need. Whatever the situation or circumstance, Mercy Street Kitchen wants to do their best to help. If that's a bag of snacks, a sleeping bag, gloves, a hot meal or detergent, they are pleased to assist.

As LaKeisha moved forward, the structure of the nonprofit consisting of volunteers and a board developed organically. It now includes Tawanda Cooper, Dewayne Cooper, Omar Richards, Carlotta Stiggers, Urich Stiggers and Lisa Fulgence. LaKeisha stated, "We also believe it is our job to help connect people back to society again. Everybody deserves dignity no matter their situation. All of them have a story, so our strong volunteer base makes things happen for this part of our community. The board members are generous and supportive."

On Tuesday, November 29, Mercy Street Kitchen is having their Thanksgiving Feast. Mercy Street Kitchen's goal is to gain trust from neighbors in need as well as assist them with regaining the life they hope for and become self-sufficient again. In addition, they envision purchasing a food truck that goes from city to city helping the homeless as they use a mobile kitchen. The volunteers of Mercy Street Kitchen don't desire any personal gain. They just want to help!

- 1 cup sour cream
- I cup Philadelphia Cream Cheese 2 8-oz. bags three cheese blend (divided use)
- 2 8-oz. bags sharp cheddar (divided use)
- **I.** Fry the bacon; reserve the grease.

2. Add the macaroni, salt and 4 Tbsp. of butter to a pot with the water. Boil 8-10 minutes; drain.

3. Add the bacon grease, pepper, heavy cream, sour cream, cream cheese, remaining butter, I bag three cheese blend and I bag of sharp cheddar into the drained macaroni. Pour all ingredients in a baking dish. 4. Add the remaining bags of cheese on

top. Bake at 425 F for 20 minutes. Broil 2-3 minutes to make a cheese crust. Remove from the oven; add the bacon on top.

Sock It To Me Cake

- 1 15.25-oz. Duncan Hines Classic **Butter Golden Cake Mix**
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 4 large eggs
- 1/3 cup vegetable oil
- 1/4 cup water

cup sour cream
 Tbsp. brown sugar
 tsp. ground cinnamon
 cup powdered sugar
 Tbsp. milk

I. Preheat the oven to 375 F; set 1/4 cup of the cake mix aside.

2. In a bowl, combine the remaining cake mix, sugar, eggs, oil, water and sour cream; mix the ingredients.

3. In another bowl, add the reserved cake mix, brown sugar and cinnamon.

4. Grease and flour a Bundt pan; pour in 1/2 of the cake batter. Sprinkle the cinnamon-sugar over the batter making sure to leave a little space between the inner and outer cake pan and the cinnamon-sugar mixture.

5. Gently spoon the remaining cake batter over the cinnamon-sugar mixture distributing evenly.

6. Place the Bundt pan in the oven; bake at 375 F for 35-40 minutes.

7 Cool for 10 minutes, then flip the cake out of the pan; cool completely on a wire rack.8. Place the powdered sugar in a small bowl; add the milk, 1 teaspoon at a time, until you reach a consistency where it is thick but pourable.

9. When the cake is cooled completely, drizzle the icing over the top of the cake.

Baked Ziti

- 1 lb. ziti pasta
- 2 tsp. salt (divided use)
- 4 Tbsp. butter
- 4 qts. water
- 1 24-oz. jar Prego Roasted Garlic and Herb Italian Spaghetti Sauce (divided use)
- 1 tsp. pepper
- I Tbsp. minced garlic
- 1/2 pkg. Philadelphia Cream Cheese
- I lb. Italian ground turkey, cooked

4. Bake for 20-30 minutes until the cheese is melted and lightly golden. Broil 2-3 minutes to add cheese crust. Serve with Garden Salad and Garlic Bread.







Pizza Burgers

I lb. ground beef
I/4 tsp. salt
I/4 tsp. pepper
I/2 tsp. garlic powder
I pkg. English muffins
I stick butter
I 24-oz. jar pizza sauce
I 8-oz. bag mozzarella cheese

I. Preheat the oven to 375 F. Brown the ground beef in a skillet while adding the salt, pepper and garlic powder.

 Cut the English muffins in half; spread on the butter. Put the muffins in the oven to toast for 3-4 minutes. Once toasted, remove the muffins from the oven.
 Top the muffins with the pizza sauce. Add the cooked ground beef. Add the mozzarella cheese on top.

Creating a border between Texas and Louisiana, Caddo Lake contains history, legends and amazing swamplands. Throughout the area, visitors find unexpected beauty and interesting features. According to the Caddo tribe, a massive earthquake formed the lake. However, geologists claim a 100-mile log jam in Louisiana flooded the low-lying basin, creating the lake. For many years, riverboats used the swollen waters, making nearby Jefferson a port city. Eventually, they cleared logs, and the lake level fell more than 10 feet, changing the shape and ending the riverboat industry. But the 26,810-acre lake thrived. In 1911, Gulf Refining Company drilled for oil, creating the first over-water platform, which produced 450 barrels of oil per day.

With a rich history, people still enjoy fishing on beautiful Caddo Lake. Known for massive bass and dozens of other fish species, the lake draws anglers. The Caddo Lake State Park, nearby Daingerfield State Park, and multiple RV parks provide spots for those who enjoy camping. For the less adventurous, numerous cabins on the lake offer a front-row view of wondrous nature.

From small fishing boats to kayaks and canoes, opportunities abound for visitors to get on the water. You might consider taking a boat tour with one of the local guides. Besides pointing out the best fishing spots, they share stories about the unexpected beauty of Caddo Lake. In many spots, lily pads dot the surface. During summer months, the water lilies bloom, showing their best colors while dancing in the lake breezes.

Land lovers might prefer a hike or a day of geocaching. While at Caddo Lake, look for multiple types of birds and fossils of paddlefish, or maybe spot a live alligator while hiking the many trails. As a precaution, swim only in designated areas. Don't feed or harass the creatures, and inform a park ranger or employee if you see the reptiles near swimming areas. Follow the rules for a worry-free adventure.

Bald cypress trees, abundant at Caddo Lake, have knees and beards, a fascinating phenomenon not possessed by other trees. The name comes from their appearance after shedding leaves. On land, the above-ground extensions of the root system grow straight, guarding the trees like tiny sentinels. When the trees grow in the water, though, the knees bend toward the parent tree. A straight knee near a watersurrounded cypress indicates a wayward root that belongs to a different tree.


Spanish moss hangs from the bald cypress trees, creating the mystical appearance we think of when picturing swamplands. Historic tribes used the moss for clothing, huts and bedding. A living organism, not truly moss, the plant absorbs nutrients from rainwater and air.

Near the state park, the Caddo Lake National Wildlife Refuge offers horseback and hiking trails, plus wildlife observation areas. Rare or threatened species, such as the peregrine falcon, alligator snapping turtles and Rafinesque's bigeared bat, inhabit the area.

For those who believe, or want to, Caddo Lake remains an alleged home for the legendary Big Foot. Many people visit the lake with cameras and video recorders, searching for a glimpse of the elusive creatures. Do they exist? With enough bravery to search, perhaps you might see one when visiting Caddo Lake. Otherwise, enjoy the unexpected beauty. And if you get bored, take the short drive into Jefferson and enjoy all it offers.
