



# TEAM HERRIANN

Dr. Rick and Suzy Herrmann show their thankfulness by volunteering and giving back to the community. Over the years, they have donated their time and energy, serving as volunteers for a variety of charities and nonprofits in the Mansfield area. The importance of giving back is something they believe in strongly and worked hard to pass on to their children.

In the '80s, the couple met at Texas A&M University. While she completed her special education degree requirements, he worked on his undergraduate degree in zoology. Following graduation and marriage, Suzy wanted to be near her parents in Fort Worth, while Rick pursued his dental degree at Baylor College of Dentistry, so they relocated to Arlington.

"Growing up, my mother was a chemistry teacher and a chemistry professor at the University of Mary Hardin-

Baylor, and my father is a U.S. Army veteran. So, we lived near Killeen. I got my love of the sciences from my mother. I became interested in dentistry from my family dentist," Dr. Herrmann acknowledged. Early in life, he knew he wanted to work in the scientific realm to help people.

As a husband-and-wife team, they planned for Suzy to work until Rick received his doctorate in orthodontics and then start a family. Suzy would become a stay-athome mom to take care of their kids. "I taught special education for 12 years, and I loved it!" Suzy stated. "I conducted life skill lessons, so my students might become self-sufficient adults. Occasionally, I see my previous students in various places working, and my heart is overwhelmed with joy. When I see them complete tasks independently, I think, I always knew they were capable."

Eventually, Rick graduated, and the couple had two daughters, Sarah and Emily, so Suzy became a full-time mommy and dedicated volunteer. Both of them have a heart for serving people, so from PTA and food drives to Special Olympics and church, Dr. Herrmann and she joined in to help. "We are blessed, so it's our duty to help











others," Suzy expressed. "When a need arises, we figure out how we can help. We're Christians, so that's what were supposed to do, right?"

Initially, Dr. Herrmann came to Mansfield to practice and discovered what a unique place Mansfield is. He said, "It has great schools, people and an excellent sense of community. The city works well together." With excitement, Suzy chimed in, "All of the pastors get together and pray over the schools during scheduled times of the year. My husband has been actively involved with multiple organizations over the years, including Mansfield Cares and Mansfield Rotary. He has been a board member of the Mansfield Chamber of Commerce and Mansfield I.S.D. Education Foundation." In addition, the Herrmanns established a scholarship that is given to a Mansfield ISD high school senior each year.

Suzy also works with Common Ground, which comes together with different religions and nonprofits to meet the needs of residents. "It's really a unique nonprofit. Mansfield takes care of its own. In 2007, I worked alongside Common Ground, which partnered with the Mansfield Kiwanis Club to create Feed the Kids. Because MISD teachers and counselors noticed many children were returning to school malnourished, this program was developed for students who received free and reduced lunch. It seemed that during the summers many kids struggled to get needed meals, so this assistance is offered to families in Mansfield Independent School District," Suzy said.

Many volunteers, including the Herrmanns, delivered meals to families who couldn't pick up food. In 2015,

Feed the Kids added a literacy program, so children can obtain books to read in the summers, too. While parents pick up food at the pantries, children select as many books as they want to take home to read. This program encourages students to increase or at least stay on reading level, which is the goal. Recently, Mansfield ISD reported that kids aren't losing literacy levels over the summer, and some have gained literacy levels since the program began. This started eight-10 years ago, so they see it as a success.



"Our daughters, Sarah and Emily, started volunteering along with us at the Feed the Kids program, which was originally at St. Jude's. I remember our girls sitting between the nuns as they talked to them and served people in the community. Being able to help others contributed to our daughters staying grounded. So much so that they both entered fields of serving people education and the medical field. Of course, they are both graduates of Mansfield High. Now Sarah Dooley is a third-grade teacher at Elizabeth Smith Elementary, and Emily Herrmann is working as a PA," Dr. Herrmann said.

While thinking back on 35 years of marriage, Dr. Herrmann and Suzy are thankful. "We can finish each other's sentences." Dr. Herrmann stated. "We believe that marriage is a holy sacrament and should be upheld in God's eyes," the Herrmanns said. "Even though it's not always easy, the effort is always worth it. Thanksgiving is a holiday that our family enjoys celebrating, and we are grateful as we reflect on all our blessings." Mansfield is an incredible town, and they are delighted to live, work and give back here. They are quite proud of their volunteer work in this area. NOW





One of the best-kept secrets is that Texas is home to four recognized Native American reservations and/or tribes — the Alabama-Coushatta Reservation near Livingston, the Ysleta de Sur Pueblo (Tigua Tribe) near El Paso, the Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas in Eagle Pass and the Lipan Apache Tribe in McAllen. The latter is only recognized by the State of Texas, but the first three tribes are recognized by the federal government, allowing three casinos to operate in Texas: Naskila Gaming in Livingston, Speaking Rock Entertainment Center in El Paso and Kickapoo Lucky Eagle Casino in Eagle Pass. Visitors are welcome to help celebrate Native American culture annually at the Duwali Hoop, held at Chandler (site of the Battle of the Neches); the Coastal Bend Council of Native Americana in Corpus Christi; the Alabama-Coushatta Pow Wow held in Livingston, where visitors can stay at the tribe's Lake Tombigbee Campground on the reservation; and the Texas Kiowa Tia-Piah Pow Wow (site varies).

For more than 14,000 years, long before their first recorded contact with some shipwrecked Europeans/Anglos in 1528, Native American peoples have made what would become Texas home, from the coast to the plains, mountains and southern regions. Karankawas fed and sheltered Cabeza de Vaca near Galveston. Farmer/trader/gatherer tribes, such as the Caddos of East Texas, had trade networks established, and on the plains, Comanches and Apaches hunted bison and other game on horseback. However, following the arrival of Europeans during the 16th century, tribal life was disrupted, and with Anglo settlements encroaching, the tribes were pushed further westward, relocated to reservations in the Oklahoma Territory or were annihilated through wars with the Anglos and other tribes or through starvation.

Today the Alabama-Coushatta reservation is the oldest in Texas. A treaty between General Sam Houston and the tribe included title to the lands in 1836, and the reservation was recognized by the federal government in 1987. Tribal members are proud of their ancestors' service to General Sam Houston during the Texas Revolution. The tribe's membership numbers around 1,300, about half of whom live on the approximately 10,200-acre reservation. A tribal council oversees the government, and health and human services are provided. The tribe made headline news in October 2022 by electing Millie Thompson Williams as its first female second tribal chief. Prior to her death in August 2023, she promoted teaching the tribe's language and customs to the youth. The principal chief is Chief Donnis Battise.

After being captured by the Spanish in 1880, and then establishing Ysleta del Sur Pueblo in 1882, Tigua Tribe built the acequia (canal) system, bringing water from the Rio Grande River to their agricultural-based society. Tribal enrollment today numbers about 4,000 members. The Pueblo's main attractions for visitors to learn about the tribe's heritage, culture and its contributions to the El Paso area are comprised of the Tigua Indian Cultural Center, Ysleta Mission de San Antonio, Speaking Rock Entertainment Center, Hueco Tanks, Tigua Trails and Chilcote Ranch near Valentine, Texas.

The Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas became one of three formally recognized Kickapoo tribes by the federal government in 1985. It had been officially recognized by the Texas Indian Commission in 1977. The tribe has nearly 2,000 enrolled members. Monies from the tribe's casino provide housing along the Rio Grande and health and education services to its peoples on the 118 acres in Eagle Pass that was granted to the tribe by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

In the 1600s, the Lipan Apache migrated to what would become Texas, and after a century of warring with the Comanches, the Lipan Apache became many "bands" or rancherías on the plains, coast and forests of Texas and across the Rio Grande River into Mexico. However, when needed, they would come together as one. Recognized by Texas only, at this time, the Lipan Apache Tribal Council is located in McAllen, and the city of Presidio and Presidio County have turned over rights to the Cemeterio del Barrio de los Lipanes to the tribe. NOW



#### **Breaking New Ground - Mansfield Continues Innovating**



#### Crystal Windows to Open the Door to Innovation in Mansfield Manufacturing

The City of Mansfield broke ground on two exciting projects on Oct. 21. 

#### Mimi's Italian Stuffed Artichokes

- 4 large whole artichokes
- 2 cups Italian breadcrumbs
- 1 cup Parmesan cheese
- 1 Tbsp. garlic powder
- I Tbsp. Tony Chachere's Creole Seasoning

Salt, to taste

#### Pepper, to taste I cup olive oil

- **1.** With a large knife, cut the tops off the artichokes; remove the thorns. Wash the artichokes; drain the excess water.
- **2.** Mix the breadcrumbs, cheese, garlic powder, Tony Chachere's, salt and pepper.
- **3.** Spread the leaves of the artichokes; sprinkle the mixture between the leaves. Drizzle the olive oil on

top of the stuffed artichokes.

- **4.** Place the artichokes in 1 inch of water; steam them with the lid on for 45-55 minutes. Add water as needed to keep the artichokes from burning.
- **5.** Remove from heat when the leaves pull apart easily.

#### Chicken Piccata

4 chicken breasts Salt, to taste

Pepper, to taste 3/4 cup flour

1 Tbsp. olive oil

2 Tbsp. butter (divided use)

1/2 cup dry white wine 1 cup chicken stock

1 3 1/2-oz. jar capers in brine, drained

3 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice

- **1.** Cut the chicken breasts in half to make thin cutlets. Cover them with plastic wrap, and bash them gently with a meat mallet or rolling pin until around 1/4-inch thick.
- **2.** Season the chicken with salt and pepper.

Dredge each cutlet in the flour; shake off any excess flour.

- 3. Heat the olive oil in a large skillet or frying pan. Once hot, fry the chicken cutlets in batches for 4 minutes on each side until golden brown and completely cooked. Place the cooked chicken on a clean plate; cover with foil to keep warm.
- 4. Reduce the heat to low; add 1 Tbsp. of butter. Once melted, add the wine and chicken stock. Increase the heat to high; whisk the sauce until it starts to thicken slightly, about 5-6 minutes.
- **5.** Add the remaining 1 Tbsp. butter, capers and lemon juice. Stir until the butter has melted. Return the chicken to the skillet; pour the sauce over the chicken. Serve.

#### Catey Jane's Famous Salted **Chocolate Chip Cookies**

1 1/3 cups all-purpose flour

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/2 tsp. baking powder

3/4 tsp. kosher salt

1/2 cup unsalted butter, melted and cooled

1/2 cup light brown sugar

1/3 cup granulated sugar



2 tsp. vanilla extract

1 1/2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips 1 tsp. sea salt

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. In a medium bowl, combine the flour, baking soda, baking powder and salt.
- 2. In a large bowl, add the melted and cooled butter, brown sugar and granulated sugar. Wisk 1-2 minutes; add the egg and vanilla; whisk until smooth.
- 3. Fold in the dry ingredients and the chocolate chips; be careful not to overmix. Scoop onto a cookie sheet; bake for 12-15 minutes, until golden brown.
- **4.** Remove the cookies from the oven; sprinkle with sea salt. Move the cookies to a cooling rack. Enjoy.










