



The human voice is a powerful instrument. We've been singing as long as we've had voices, and song has a way of touching our hearts and connecting us to memories and dreams. Song becomes even more powerful when it's performed in groups, and many of the great composers wrote choral works as well as instrumental music. Many people have fond memories of choir in high school, or maybe at church, though many churches no longer use choral music. The Silver Serenaders is an adult choir made up of individuals from all over the area who are keeping this powerful music alive.

Chett Haynes is the current director of this group. "We used to be a choir for senior citizens, but we removed the age requirement, and now some of the children of members are also members. Our oldest member is Johnye Williams. She's 103. Our youngest is Naomi Fisher who is 46. We have both singers and instrumentalists. We have the choir, a chorale, carolers and an instrumental ensemble. We recently added a ukulele group this year. Some of them had never played before, but they're learning fast!"

The Silver Serenaders present programs that combine sacred, secular and patriotic music. "We present variety in our concerts. Our last concert tour was titled, 'This Is the Dream,' and included songs like 'Dream,' 'Climb Every Mountain,' 'Put a Little Love in Your Heart,' 'God Bless America,' 'How Great Thou Art' and 'You Make Me Feel So Young,' which features Johnye, our 103-year-old."

"We have 25 songs to memorize for our new program," President and CEO Mary Crawford informed. "It's a church program called, 'Total Praise,' which includes the song by that name. That song is huge. There's such a variety of music in the program. We allow our new members to use the sheet music until they have the songs memorized. It's great once you can sing the songs without the music, because then you get to watch Chett's antics as he conducts!"



"It's great when, occasionally, you make suggestions to the choir and actually see them trying to do it!" Chett mused. "Music is therapy. It enhances your mood. It's respiratory therapy when you have to control your breathing. And the memorization is good mental therapy. Studies show music can enhance your quality of life. And the social interaction of the choir is good for you, too. It's meaningful to be in an organization like this. It adds purpose, an opportunity to serve, give and invest."

Mary thinks the same way. "I've always sung in a choir. My life wouldn't be the same if I wasn't singing. It wouldn't seem like I was doing anything."

The Silver Serenaders are a community of their own. They provide each other with rides, not just to practices, but to doctor's appointments and other things. They take food to each other and send cards of encouragement when they are ill. "Our chaplain is great. She checks in on everyone," Mary said. "This choir started in 1981. This is our 43rd season,






and we've traveled everywhere. The Air Force chapel in Colorado Springs, Hawaii, Carnegie Hall, the Meyerson Symphony Center, National City Christian Church in Washington, D.C., L.A., all up and down the West Coast, Israel. We've even sung in restaurants! James and Betty Palmer were our founders, and Chett has been our leader since 2011."

"I choose the music and run the concerts. Mary does everything else," Chett confided.

"I handle the day-to-day mission of keeping the organization going," Mary clarified. "I joined the choir in 2006, and I've been the president since 2010. I worked at Baylor hospital in fundraising, so I knew computers and was good at record keeping. But we have 48 officers who help keep things running."

"We practice from August to May and take the summers off," Chett informed. "We do four to five concerts in the fall and another four to five in the spring. We're planning a tour now of East Texas, Arkansas and Branson. We welcome new members. You don't have to read music, and we don't even have an audition. Word of mouth brings new members. We like to have fun. Our rehearsals are fun. Our concerts are fun. It's important to have high quality, but this is a volunteer organization. If people don't want to be there, they don't come. Anyone who is available at 4:30 p.m. on Mondays is welcome. We rehearse at Hillcrest Baptist Church in Cedar Hill. You don't have to have some wonderful musical talent to join. Everyone has an important part." NOW

Thanksgiving is the perfect time to pull out old family favorites, but it is also a good time to try a new recipe. Below are some ideas you might consider to give a new flare to your holiday celebration. Happy dining! Now

#### **Drunken Turkey**

Provided by Paula Beavers for the November 2019 issue of SouthwestNOW Magazine.

Large turkey, cut in half lengthwise Salt, to taste
Pepper, to taste
2 tsp. poultry seasoning
1 bottle champagne
16 oz. chicken broth
1 orange, cut in quarters
1 lemon, cut in quarters

- I lime, cut in quarters
  I head of garlic
  I onion, chopped
- **I.** Cover both turkey halves with salt, pepper and poultry seasoning; arrange turkey so the button will still pop up when done.
- **2.** Pour entire bottle of champagne over the bird, along with the chicken broth. Add the cut up fruits, the whole head of garlic (do not chop) and onions.

**3.** This turkey will cook quicker cut in half, and the breasts will not dry out. You will not taste any alcohol, and you can take liberties with the spices you like to use.

#### **Corn Bread Dressing**

Provided by Tonya Willis for the December 2021 issue of North Ellis Co.NOW Magazine.

1 cup cornmeal
1/2 cup flour
1 egg
2 Tbsp. sugar
1 tsp. salt
2 tsp. baking powder
Milk, for consistency
1 Tbsp. margarine or butter
1 medium white onion, chopped

1/2 red or green bell pepper4 stalks celery, chopped

2 Tbsp. chicken soup base mix1 14.5-oz. can cream of chicken soup

I 14.5-oz. can of water Garlic powder, to taste Onion powder, to taste

Pepper, to taste
Salt, to taste
I small bunch green onions, finely
chopped

- **1.** Mix the cornmeal, flour, egg, sugar, salt, baking powder and milk. Bake at 400 F for 35-45 minutes.
- **2.** When the combread is ready; warm butter or margarine in a pan. Sauté the onions, bell peppers and celery.
- **3.** Combine the combread with the sauteed vegetables and all remaining ingredients. Add the green onions last. Bake in the oven for 1 hour at 350 E

#### Thanksgiving Cranberry Jalapeño Dip

6 cups cranberries

2 jalapeños, diced 2 tsp. cumin

1 cup cilantro, chopped

2 tsp. salt

4 cups sugar

1 32-oz. pkg. cream cheese Ritz crackers, or crackers of your choice

- **1.** Add cranberries to a food processor; chop into small pieces.
- **2.** Combine cranberries, jalapeños, cumin, cilantro and salt in a large bowl.
- 3. Add sugar to mixture; stir well.
- **4.** Cover mixture; refrigerate for 3 hours.
- **5.** Spread cream cheese in the bottom of a casserole dish.
- **6.** Pour chilled mixture over the cream cheese; serve with crackers.

2/3 cup sugar
1/2 tsp. salt
1/3 cup margarine or butter
1 cup white corn syrup
1 cup pecans, chopped, or to taste
1 9-inch piecrust

**1.** In a bowl, mix all ingredients, except the piecrust; pour mixture into the piecrust. **2.** Bake at 375 F for 45-50 minutes; cool before serving.



From enjoying fresh seafood at Fisherman's Wharf and ferrying across the bay to Alcatraz to walking the iconic Golden Gate Bridge and capturing a few photos along Lombard Street, San Francisco definitely has a multitude of must-sees for visitors. With high temperatures in the upper 50s during the winter months and in the 60s to low 70s the remainder of the year, any season is a good time to visit this California treat.

If you plan to fly, San Francisco International Airport offers easy access to rental vehicles via a short airport shuttle ride, or visitors can take a cab, rideshare service or the subway system to their destination. A couple of blocks west, Fisherman's Wharf offers restaurants galore, plus activities for the entire family, including Madame Tussauds and Ripley's Believe It or Not! Take a bike, Segway or cable car to tour the area for dining, shopping and other entertainment options.

Nearby, ferry rides depart for the infamous Alcatraz Island. Several tour options of the former maximum-security federal prison that once housed Al Capone are offered. If you cannot take the ferry trip, don't fret. You can catch a glimpse of "The



Rock" from land while looking out across the bay.

If it is souvenirs that suit your fancy, you can purchase a few Alcatraz-related items and more at the Golden Gate Bridge Welcome Center. Twice a week, the local nonprofit, San Francisco City Guides, provides free walking tours of the iconic bridge. Make sure to register beforehand. If guests want to take a leisurely hike in the area, they can enjoy the scenery and vistas at Golden Gate National Recreation Area.

A trip to San Francisco would be incomplete without a visit to Lombard Street. It carries the distinction of the "crookedest street in the world," and drivers can slowly maneuver around each of the eight curves down the steep grade. Tourists might prefer to walk along Lombard Street, stopping briefly to grab a few pictures in front of the flowerbeds, if in bloom, and other landscaping. Soak in the architecture of the homes as you join others experiencing the fun of this iconic tourist spot. Parking is available along the street at the entrance of that section of Lombard Street, but try to avoid rush hour.

Before heading home, visitors should make time to feel the spray of the Pacific Ocean. There are public access points along the coast, so check out the area on an online map to find the perfect spot to visit.

Travelers should do their research and select as many popular sites and attractions as possible to visit during their trip. San Francisco is a treat, so plan a trip to this West Coast city today.


