



A CENTURY



For more than a century, the Ray family has called Mansfield home. With four generations rooted in the community, Danny and Suzanne Ray's stories are woven tightly into the town's growth, from the days when Mansfield was just a small farming community to the thriving city it is today.

"My family's history in Mansfield stretches back to the late 1800s, when my great-grandmother, whom we called Grandmother Ball, raised 13 children here," Suzanne explained. "My mother, Jean Perry, graduated from Mansfield High School in 1922 and became well-known in the community for music, playing both piano and organ. My mother served as the executive director of the Mansfield Chamber of Commerce for nine years. Also, many of the schools are named after my parents' friends and our teachers. Ironically, most of my teachers taught my father and me, too."

The Ray family moved to Mansfield in 1954 and established the original Ray's Pharmacy on Main Street. They became members of First Baptist Church of Mansfield, where Suzanne's family attended and found community — a tradition that continues today. Suzanne and Danny's paths crossed at church, and she began working at his family's business. At the age of 14, she began dating Danny with her parents' permission. "He was 17, a little older than me, but they were OK with it because they thought he was an upstanding young man. After I graduated high school, we got married," Suzanne said with a smile.

Danny observed his father for many years and wanted to follow in his footsteps. He learned not just the business, but also the values that guide him. "I noticed that my dad made everybody feel important," Danny recalled. "That's what he showed me my whole life, so it was instilled in me to do the same."


Since he is three years older than Suzanne, Danny immediately enrolled in college after he graduated from high school. Before applying to Southwestern State College in Weatherford, Oklahoma, for pharmacy school, he finished his foundational coursework at Tarrant County Junior College. Meanwhile, Suzanne enrolled in a pre-pharmacy program to acquire her degree as well.


Eventually, Danny graduated and began working as a pharmacist. In 1979, he purchased the business from his father, who retired at the age of 52. "I needed Suzanne's help, so she started working in the business alongside me doing bookkeeping, purchasing and traveling to the other stores to manage the business," Danny said. Over the next 43 years, Danny and Suzanne expanded Ray's Pharmacy into locations in Mansfield, Arlington, Kennedale and Hamilton.

As they managed their finances well, they lived in the house his grandfather built. "I remember them building the golf course on Walnut Creek, and I thought, *That's not going to work,*" he said with a smirk. Eventually, the couple built their forever home on what had been Rawdon farmland in the 1900s.

Faith and family have been constants in their journey. Both Suzanne and Danny have remained active at First Baptist Church. They also cared for their parents in their later years. Danny's father lived to 97 and Suzanne's mother to 94. Both of them enjoyed full lives in Mansfield.

From business to church life, from community leadership to family traditions, the Rays have left a lasting imprint on this city. Danny and Suzanne often reflect with gratitude. "I don't





consider myself to be the sharpest knife in the drawer. Only the Lord has allowed us to be so fortunate," Danny added humbly.

Since they retired and sold all of the Ray Pharmacies, Danny likes to hunt more. His father taught him how to hunt sparrows when he was about 9 years old, but today, his hunting ventures have expanded to being guided by a professional hunter who assists him as he hunts for elk, deer, elephants, fox, sheep, warthogs and other animals. He said, "Recently, my grandson and I went to South Africa to hunt. We purchased hunting licenses to hunt specific species. In certain places this helps manage the overpopulation of some animals, which can be a nuisance for farmers. Killing animals creates resources that provide food and income for many people."

"I used to have some calves, wild ducks, bulls and chickens on our land," Suzanne said. "I incubated eggs, and that was hard work. Eventually, I got rid of the animals and started to enjoy shooting flying fish. It's so much fun, not as adventurous and dangerous as Danny's hunting ventures."

"I'm fascinated by many animals and enjoy the challenge of outsmarting them," Danny added.

"My father used to bring cattle from Fairfield through Mansfield to Fort Worth, and he thought it was such a small little country town that he passed in a blink. He never dreamed that he would live here, nor create generations in this place," Danny said.

Today, the Ray family continues to be recognized as a pillar of Mansfield — not just for their business success, but for their faith, their generosity and their enduring commitment to the community. They love the city they've always called home. **NOW**

Dr. Man Le's career began as a software engineer in the late '90s and continued through the early 2000s. While the 1990s saw significant growth and innovation in the technology industry, it was not without its share of difficulties and layoffs. The industry experienced both boom and bust cycles during this period, leading to job cuts in certain areas.



"I considered making a transition to the medical field as I watched my brother enjoy his work as a dentist. Working as an employee for companies seemed unstable, so I started taking prerequisite classes after hours while I worked for the software company," Dr. Le said.



Together As One: Mansfield Unveils its First Community-Collaborative Mural

The City of Mansfield unveiled a new public art piece, "Together As One," in October 2025 along the Pond Branch Trail within Historic Downtown Mansfield.

The billboard mural came together as a result of community collaboration and is representative of the City's growing commitment to public art. The mural was born from a series of community focus groups where residents shared thoughts on what brings the community together.

Local artist, Kirsten Maiwald, led these discussions and then crafted the themes into the design of the mural, celebrating unity. The mural was then painted over a weekend in September, as residents of all ages and abilities

came together to paint it. The artwork is centered by a pair of light-skinned and dark-skinned hands intertwined and forming the trunk of a tree. Its treetop is crowned with familial silhouettes having remarkable experiences together. The artwork's base features iconic images from Mansfield's history. This piece, like its imagery, really depicts what it means to live life together in Mansfield and underscores the spirit of community.

"Together As One" represents the beginning of Mansfield's Public Arts Program. In 2023, the City adopted its first Cultural Arts Master Plan, a landmark document outlining how arts and culture can enrich residents' lives. As part of this adoption, the City identified the desire

to implement a formal Public Arts Program in order to strategically bring art into the city's spaces.

In alignment, the City Council adopted the Percent-for-Art Program, dedicating up to 2% of the value of eligible capital projects to fund public art. This funding will allow art to remain a focal point within the community and ensure that, as the city grows, so will unique and special projects that make Mansfield home.

The City will unveil a second art piece along the Pond Branch Trail in spring 2026. Themed Celebrations and Traditions. It will be inspired by conversations from the city's second annual Common Table event held in October.




CookingNOW IN THE KITCHEN WITH VALERIE JONES

"Cooking runs deep in my family. My mom has a gift of pulling something from the fridge and pantry to create an amazing meal from nothing. And, the women in my husband's family are wonderful cooks as well as some of the men. Our Thanksgivings are incredible. The host cooks the turkey, and everyone else contributes side dishes and desserts. We eat in the early afternoon, go for a walk, settle in for some football and eat again ... and again!" Banana Pudding Pie

Crust:

1 11-oz. box vanilla wafers (divided use)
1/2 cup butter, melted
2 large ripe bananas, sliced

Vanilla Cream Filling:

3/4 cup sugar
1/3 cup all-purpose flour
2 large eggs
4 egg yolks
2 cups whole milk
2 tsp. vanilla extract

Meringue:

4 egg whites, save yolks for filling
1/2 cup sugar

1. For the crust: Set aside 30 wafers for later use. Crush the remaining wafers; stir in the butter. Place the mixture in a 9-inch pie plate;

firmly press into the bottom, sides and onto the lip of the plate to create a crust.

2. Bake at 350 F for 10-12 minutes. Then, place on a wire rack until cool.
3. Arrange the banana slices evenly over the bottom of the cooled crust.
4. For the filling: Whisk the first 5 ingredients in saucepan. Cook over medium heat, whisking constantly 8-10 minutes. Remove from heat; stir in the vanilla.
5. Immediately spread half of the hot filling over the bananas. Top with 20 wafers; place the remaining filling over the wafers.
6. For the meringue: Using an electric mixer, beat the egg whites at high speed until foamy. Add 1 Tbsp. of sugar at a time; beat until stiff peaks form and the sugar dissolves. Spread the meringue evenly over the filling, sealing the edges. Bake at 350 F for 10-12 minutes. Remove from oven; let cool on a wire rack for 1 hour. Decorate with the remaining wafers (crushed or whole). Chill 4 hours.

Dutch Oven Pot Roast

3 lbs. boneless beef chuck roast
1 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
1 tsp. ground black pepper
2 Tbsp. olive oil
2 large yellow onions, peeled and cut into large chunks
4 cloves garlic, roughly chopped
1 cup dry red wine
2 cups beef broth
1 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
2 Tbsp. tomato paste
2 sprigs fresh rosemary
2 bay leaves
1 lb. baby carrots
1 1/2 lbs. baby potatoes
8 oz. mushrooms (optional)

1. Preheat the oven to 300 F.
2. Season the meat with salt and black pepper on all sides.
3. Heat the oil in a large 7- to 8-quart Dutch oven over medium-high heat. Sear the meat on each side until brown. Remove from the pot; set aside.
4. Reduce to medium heat; add the onions and sauté for about 3 minutes, scraping the bottom and sides of the pot. Stir in the chopped garlic; cook for 1 more minute.
5. Add the red wine and quickly deglaze the brown bits from the bottom and sides of the pot. Then, add broth, Worcestershire sauce, tomato paste, rosemary and bay leaves. Stir until evenly combined and bring to a low boil.
6. Return the meat to the pot with its juices. The liquid should cover about half of the meat. Cover; bake for 1 1/2 hours at 300 F.
7. Remove from the oven; spoon the juice over the top of the roast. Add the baby carrots, potatoes and mushrooms. Cover; return to the oven. Cook for 2 hours more until the meat and vegetables are tender.
