Story of Redemption

Curiosity led to a life-changing breakthrough for Weatherford resident Justen Morrison. On his way to a church service while serving time on a drug charge in the Parker County Jail in 2021, Justen discovered a toServe Ministries brochure. He noticed the nonprofit was local, further drawing him to learn more. “It was wonderful. It was probably one of the best decisions I’ve ever made. I knew I needed to do something different. Something had to change. I couldn’t go back to that lifestyle again,” Justen shared. What clicked? “I guess God had had enough.”

Raised in a Christian home, Justen was no stranger to the Bible, but certain life choices had led him astray. Justen had used methamphetamines for several years and was convicted and sentenced for dealing. “The drug wasn’t my addiction. It was the power from the dealing — the feeling of being wanted. That was more of where my addiction lied.” Once behind bars, Justen’s mindset changed, and he began his journey with toServe Ministries.

The toServe program partners incarcerated men and women across the United States with mentors from a Bible Correspondence Fellowship course. Like pen-pals, the mentors guide students through lessons and help them grow in their faith. “When you’re locked up, having someone invest their time in you and write letters, it’s almost like Christmas. It matters a lot,” Justen said.

Justen's first mentor, Randy Herring, guided him through the Bible lessons while he served just over a year in the Parker County Jail. When Justen was transferred to a Houston facility, he was introduced to his second mentor, Larry Fuller, through letters. After completing the initial toServe lessons, Justen desired to continue in his personal growth. "Larry took it upon himself to find a whole different set of lessons that he started sending me to keep me engaged and focused on what I needed to do."

Justen challenged himself to finish the lessons and received a certificate of completion. It was an important step for him, as he dropped out of high school three months prior to graduation in 2001. Although he received his GED a few months later, Justen considers this one of his lifelong regrets, so completing the toServe program was significant. "It was bittersweet. I was happy to be done. I felt accomplished, but I didn't want it to go away," he shared.

The second phase of the toServe program is re-entry assistance to help recently released inmates successfully transition back into society. After being paroled in the fall of 2023, Justen finally had the chance to meet his toServe mentor, Randy, in person. "I was overcome with joy when we met face to face for the first time just days after his release," Randy shared. "I thought I knew him, but the time we spent together in the following weeks revealed so much more about him — hardworking, self-reliant, honest, loving and committed to building a better life."

Randy drove Justen to get his birth certificate, social security card and driver's license. He took him to church every Sunday. Randy calls Justen's story one of redemption. "There were many tears of joy shed when Justen was baptized on Christmas Eve two years ago, and we all have come to feel blessed to be able to call him a friend and brother in Christ."

Justen's mentor, Larry, helped him find work after his release. "He diligently worked and did the next right thing," Larry said. "By doing the next right thing, walking with wisdom and by God's grace, Justen has a good job. He is a good citizen now."

Justen now has his own place, a full-time job and attends Trinity Bible

Church each week. "I'm just working on it every day. I thank God for all the blessings He's given me. I couldn't have done it without Him and all the people from my church."

Randy and Larry have also been blessings in his life, and Justen continues to build relationships with them. He often shares his story of redemption through toServe to show others there is hope. "If it helps somebody else see a way through whatever they're going through, then that's what I want it to do. I know who I am, and I'm proud of who I am. I've made mistakes. I'm out of it, and here I am on the other side of it."

He believes toServe is successful because the mentors care about those they are ministering to. Justen added that the lifestyle the person chooses once out of prison determines if they will be successful. "I wanted to surround myself with God-fearing people, people who will walk that walk. You are who you associate with. If you want to be successful, you hang around people who are successful."

Conversations and time with family



members, including his 93-year-old grandmother, "Pete," and church keep him busy on the weekends. When he has a little downtime, Justen enjoys fishing, drawing and playing video games with his son. He enjoys volunteering when toServe needs his assistance, and he said he would be open to mentoring in the future. "If I can help one more person, it will be all

worth it. Try to pay it forward."

Justen said he will be forever grateful for toServe and his mentors but added that he had to do his part to be successful. People must take accountability and ask for help, if necessary. "You have to be committed to make a change. People say they want to change all the time," Justen stated. "How bad do you want it?" **NOW**

Home is a place of comfort and peace. Home is a sanctuary for its residents — a familiar place where one finds safety and stability. When home life is interrupted by a surgery or the realization that additional help is needed with daily tasks, Home Sweet Homehealth, LLC offers convenient services in the privacy of one's own home.

Denise Deapen, owner of Home Sweet Homehealth, has worked in the health care industry since college. Denise first opened the business in Fort Worth in 2010 to serve residents



across Parker, Tarrant, Johnson, Hood and Palo Pinto counties. As a Parker County resident, she eventually moved the business to Aledo. "We decided to move the business to Parker County because we saw a need," she said. "We were receiving more referrals from the area, and most of the staff live in Parker County."

Home Sweet Homehealth provides skilled nursing, home health aides and Certified Nursing Assistants, as well as therapists for physical, speech and occupational therapies. Services range from medication assistance, exercise programs, wound dressing and IVs to bathing and after-surgery care.

Rehabilitation facilities, assisted living residences or nursing homes provide necessary care depending on individual needs. Home Sweet Homehealth wants locals to know there is another service available to utilize. "A lot of them won't go get the medical attention they need because they don't want to go to a nursing home for rehab," said Lorie Wright, office manager. "By giving people knowledge of home health, they can get their medical attention in home because

we come to them." Even if a patient recovers from surgery at a rehabilitation facility, additional help may be needed following discharge. Home Sweet Homehealth can help. "They heal faster in their homes. They feel comfortable, and they're more relaxed because they are in their own environment."

Home Sweet Homehealth offers services for residents who need help with medication, personal hygiene, cooking and more. "When you can't do things safely, that's the big key. If you're unable to bathe safely, cook safely, clean your house safely, do wound care or are worried about your meds, that's when home health would be beneficial," Denise said.

Many patients are referred by their children, Veterans Affairs or by physicians. Home Sweet Homehealth provides staff for services based on the needs of the patient. "We could be in there one day a week, or we could be in there five days a week. It could be for a few weeks to a year," Lorie said. "We want to help you where you're at. We want to help you do what you need to do and do it safely."

Home Sweet Homehealth staff members undergo training, and many hold state licenses in the field. "It takes a very special person to be willing to go into someone else's home and give them that level and standard of care," Denise shared. Staff can help during the day, but no overnight care is available. Home Sweet Homehealth accepts multiple insurances after verification, VA, traditional Medicare and private pay.

"We're a lot more personable because we are a smaller, local business. We've all been in this industry forever," Denise said. "There is not a big chain corporation where people in other states are mandating what we do. It's us. We decide what needs to be done for each patient." **NOW**





CookingNOW IN THE KITCHEN WITH BOB BRAUER

When it involves cuisine, tradition is important to Weatherford resident Bob Brauer. "Turkey and ham at Thanksgiving. Cornish game hens or prime rib at Christmas," he shared. "And barbecue every chance I get."

Bob first learned to cook by watching his mother. He picked up additional tips through cooking shows, specifically by the late Justin Wilson, who is best known for his Cajun dishes.

Recipes gathered from Bob's mother, friends and the Internet are some of his favorites, but he might adapt them to fit his tastes. "My wife gets mad with me because I don't remember how I made a dish that she liked," he joked. Bob's go-to spice is of his own making. He incorporates the all-purpose rub comprised of salt, pepper and granulated garlic into most of his recipes. [NOW](#)

Kilroy's Meatloaf

Meatloaf:

1 lb. 80/20 ground beef
1 lb. ground pork
2 eggs, lightly beaten
1 cup Panko breadcrumbs
3/4 cup cheddar cheese
1 medium onion, finely diced
4 cloves garlic, minced
1/4 cup parsley, chopped
1/4 cup ketchup
1/2 cup tomato sauce
1/2 cup milk
1 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
1 tsp. salt
1/2 tsp. 16 mesh black pepper

1/2 tsp. granulated garlic
1 Tbsp. Italian seasoning

Glaze:

1/2 cup ketchup
8 oz. tomato sauce
2 tsp. white vinegar
1/4 cup brown sugar
3 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
1 tsp. garlic powder
1/2 tsp. onion powder
1/2 tsp. black pepper
Pinch cayenne pepper
Pinch paprika

1. For the meatloaf: Preheat the oven to 375 F. In a large bowl, add all the ingredients;

mix well.

2. Form the meatloaf; add it to a greased loaf pan or glass dish. Bake, uncovered, for 40 minutes.

3. For the glaze: Add all of the ingredients to a bowl; mix well. Glaze the meatloaf after baking 40 minutes. Continue baking for 15-20 minutes, or until the internal temperature is 165 F. Rest for 10 minutes before slicing.

Chicken Pot Pie

1/3 cup butter
1 cup celery, chopped
1 cup carrots, peeled and chopped
1/4 cup onion, chopped
1 cup frozen peas
1 cup red potatoes, cubed (optional)
1/3 cup flour
1 tsp. salt
1/2 tsp. thyme, crushed
1/2 tsp. paprika
1/4 tsp. black pepper
1 3/4 cups chicken broth
1/2 cup milk
1 whole cooked rotisserie chicken, deboned and cubed
2 9-inch pastry deep dish pie shells

1. Preheat the oven to 425 F. Melt the butter in a large skillet; add the celery and the next 3 ingredients. Add the potatoes, if desired. Sauté for 8-10 minutes.

2. Stir in the flour; add the salt and the next 3 ingredients. Add the broth and milk; stir until thickened.

3. Add the cooked chicken; combine well.

4. Line an ungreased pie pan with one pie crust. Spoon the mixture into the pie pan; add the second pie crust on top, crimp the edges and slit the top. Bake for 15 minutes, then cover the edges with foil. Continue baking another 15 minutes, or until the internal temperature is 165 F.
