

At Home With Lyn Whittaker and Beverly Davis





Since 2007, Lyn Whittaker and Beverly Davis have shared a home in Burleson. Five years ago, Beverly's son, Luther, asked to move in with them. Now her grandchildren, Tyler, Tomaya and Trey, live there, too. Lovers of Christmas, they all look forward to opening their home to family and friends. Beverly said, "I like to walk in, and Christmas rains down on you." Every year, they choose a different theme and decorate the entire home. Every room holds a touch of the holiday, but upstairs, Beverly creates a masterpiece — a Christmas village, which takes at least 27 hours to assemble. Lyn built platforms for the village, but when it comes to placing each piece, she steps back and lets Bev take control.

Born in Arizona, Lyn's father served in the Air Force and met her mom in Germany. Her dad's mother lived in New Orleans, Louisiana, which she made her home for 48 years. She spent 35 years working with mentally and physically disabled people. Now retired, she volunteers with Huguley Hospital, Hope Center and local food banks. She enjoys taking meals to elderly shut-ins.

Originally from New Orleans, Louisiana, Bev works for Texas Health and Human Services. Despite long days, she loves her job helping people. She chose a home in Burleson because of academics and the community's friendliness. A gospel singer, Bev traveled the world, but it became too demanding for a single mother. A constant in her life, religion remains important to her.

Because they share Christmas as a favorite holiday, they host parties with about 30 guests. "I'll feed anyone," Beverly said with a smile. "Christmas brings out the better side of people. It brings out calmness, sweetness, gentleness and compassion. Even mean people become gentler."

Lyn agreed, "Christmas brings family and friends together. It's a fun time of year. We take the kids for rides through the neighborhood and have even gone to Polar Express."

For at least two or three years ahead, Bev knows what she wants to do for Christmas. Each year, she delights in changing themes and colors. The basics remain the same, with collections of nutcrackers and Santa figurines, and an outdoor display that

warms the hearts of those driving by. In the front entry, a curved staircase creates a perfect niche for a tall, slender Christmas tree. They enjoy adding a matching touch of decor to the banister.

A formal dining area provides the perfect place for a festive table, which holds delicious tastes of the season. An avid cook, Bev looks forward to preparing a feast of treats and sharing them with family and friends.

Last year, they used nutcrackers as a theme. This year, they plan to feature winter white, blue and gold. Next year, she'll switch to warm colors. "I just know what I want," Bev said. "If it's gonna be done, it's gotta be right."

A smaller tree graces the family room. Tomaya decorates that tree now, learning at a young age to take on her grandmother's flare for Christmas decorating. Fun objects fill the rooms, including a 49-year-old Santa music box. It was Bev's daughter's first present. Santa, in the kitchen, acts as their security guard, a mere 35 years old. For a birthday present, Lyn gave Bev a Santa's toy shop figure as the newest "toy."

Bev shared, "I just like Christmas. The kids love it no matter how early we put it up, or how late we take it down."

"Christmas was my mom's favorite holiday. I just go along with it," Lyn admitted with a grin. Although Lyn helps decorate inside the house, she and the kids take on setting up the exterior lighted display.

At the top of the stairs, an open room serves as the perfect place to feature the Christmas village. Despite the many hours required to create the scene, Bev considers it worth every minute. She prefers tackling the job by herself and simply loves putting it together. She builds layers with larger





trees in front and smaller in back to craft a three-dimensional look. Spanning 20 feet wide and coming out 15 feet, the village lights up the entire room.

While she changes up things from year-to-year, many parts remain the same, with themes running throughout. A river runs through the tiny village with a waterfall, amusement park, campground, schools, churches and a beautiful night sky. A train encircles part of the village, capturing the attention of young and old. The entire scene comes to life with movement and lights, mesmerizing everyone. Sometimes, children get on the floor and look up, which gives them a different view than when they stand beside the village.

With 175 buildings, hundreds of various-sized trees, miniature people, vehicles, and animals plus other pieces such as carousels, the scene evokes a magical atmosphere. Surrounding strings of twinkling lights enhance the overall appearance. Beverly explained, "I want it to look like an authentic story."

For decades, both Lyn and Bev have frequented Christmas stores wherever they go. Because they enjoy traveling, they take trips about once a month, but many elements of the village came as gifts.

"We find them at garage sales, sidewalk sales, thrift stores or people give them to us," Lyn said. "While we seldom pay full price, we found one 10-piece collection we splurged on."

Bev added, "In a Paris, Texas, antique store, we bought 25 houses with figurines. Some were collectibles."

With the labor of love completed, Lyn and Bev gear up for this year's festivities. As they greet visitors with warmth, friendship and tasty food, most will find their way upstairs. And in that quiet space, perhaps the magic of a tiny village will transport them to moments of peace.

Their diamonds come from a third-generation cutter in Tel Aviv. They now offer lab-grown diamonds as another option for customers. Chemically, optically and physically the same as natural diamonds, overall, they cost less, but maintain high quality. As with all their jewels, Gayla strives to make sure she carries the best quality and sells certified stones.

With an incredible staff of jewelers, Southern Gem offers a

selection of distinctive designs in rings, necklaces, bracelets and earrings, ready for purchase. One of the newest offerings, barrel-aged rings, includes fascinating designs with wooden inlays from whiskey, bourbon, rye or wine barrels.

While they also repair jewelry and size rings, customers know them best for custom designs. Visiting the Cartier Exhibit in Dallas, Gayla drew inspiration from their originals. "I long to create those types of designs," she admitted. Creating a piece from scratch represents an opportunity for the jewelers at Southern Gem to showcase their creativity. During the design phase, they use computer-aided design software to perfect a customer's idea. At no extra charge, they provide a 3-D rendering of the proposed work and can tweak the design before creating the final jewelry.







Pretzel M&M Hugs

Angel Morris – a fun way to involve kids in the kitchen.

Servings: One bag of Hugs contains about 75 pieces (one batch). The bags of M&Ms and pretzels yield 4-5 batches total.

1 16-oz. bag Snyder's Snaps Pretzels, square shaped (not butter flavored)

I II-oz. bag HERSHEY's Hugs chocolates (or your favorite flavor) I II.4-oz. bag red and green M&Ms

I. Preheat the oven to 200 F. Line a cookie sheet with a baking mat or parchment paper. Place the pretzels on the cookie sheet in a single layer; top each pretzel with 1 HERSHEY'S chocolate.

 Bake 4-6 minutes, or until the chocolate is shiny and soft, not totally melted!
 Remove from the oven; carefully place I
 M&M in the center of each soft Hug. Press down on the M&M to spread the chocolate.
 Place in the freezer or refrigerator for I0-15 minutes, allowing the chocolate to set. Store in an airtight container. Note: If using multiple flavors of HERSHEY'S Kisses, make each flavor in its own batch as melting times will differ from flavor to flavor.

 Sprinkle the dressing mix over everything. Add black pepper to taste.
 Drizzle the butter over the top. Cover with foil; bake at 350 F for 1 hour and 10 minutes.

Nebber's Rolls With Modern Twist Sandra Walters

I cup shortening

- 2 1/4 cups water (divided use)
 1 1/2 cups sugar
 1 1/2 tsp. salt
 3 pkgs. instant dry yeast
- 3 eggs

8 cups flour

2 sticks butter, melted

I. Place the shortening, 1 1/4 cups water, sugar and salt in a bowl; heat the ingredients in the microwave for about 30 seconds. Stir until the shortening is melted; cool to lukewarm.

2. In a large bowl, dissolve the instant dry yeast in 1 cup lukewarm water.

3. Add the shortening mixture and eggs; gradually add the flour, beating well with a spoon.

4. Once combined, knead until soft, circular and elastic. Place the dough in a greased bowl, turning once to grease the top of the dough.

5. Cover with a cloth; let rise in a warm place for 10-15 minutes.

6. Roll out flat; cut using a small, circular cup on a flat surface. Dip the cut out dough into the melted butter. Fold in half; place the dough close together in greased baking pans.
7. Bake at 350 F for 15-20 minutes. Brush with butter and serve.
