



In the United States, the history and customs of the African-American culture are honored during the month of February. The observance, which was originally only one week long, was extended to a month in 1976. President Gerald R. Ford officially recognized Black History Month and called upon the public to honor the historic contributions of Black people. We share the accomplishments of Chiketa Williams as we celebrate this rich culture.

Chiketa's compassionate nature has been ingrained in her since childhood. "I watched my parents consistently give to others. We opened our home up to those in need and actively volunteered at various functions," she said.

In 10th grade, her grandfather moved into their home, and they shared a room. "He had been diagnosed with dementia, and at that time, we really didn't know what that was. As I learned about his health condition, I became one of the caregivers for him along with the rest of my family. This is where the desire to pursue a career in nursing originated," she admitted.

After graduating from high school, Chiketa attended nursing school to become a licensed vocational nurse (LVN). Eventually, she moved to Louisiana, where she worked with experienced nurses' aides and nurses, acquiring excellent nursing skills. She spent many years working there before moving back to the DFW region to be near her family. "When I got a job, I was shocked to discover that the employees there didn't advocate for patients' rights like they had at my previous position," she remembered.

As Chiketa cared for others, she was diagnosed herself with stage 1 triple-negative breast cancer. While fighting for her



life, she had a double mastectomy, chemotherapy, breast reconstruction and several other surgeries. During this process, "I learned that I was so busy taking care of others that I had neglected my own health. People who serve must conduct 'self-care' to effectively impact others," she confessed.

Dealing with these health conditions allowed her to see the different needs that people encounter when struggling in a variety of ways, so she created Chiketa Cares Foundation Inc., a nonprofit that offers financial assistance for mammograms, treats patients without insurance and assists with groceries and utilities for those who can't afford them. She networks with others and creates charitable



events to serve as many as possible. This nonprofit organization bridges the gap for struggling individuals and families who face financial and other challenges by providing temporary assistance and education, which foster lifelong changes. When Chiketa married Demarcus Williams on August 19, 2022, they asked for the guests to donate to the Chiketa Cares Foundation instead of giving them gifts.

As her concern for the community increased, she desired to educate more people about their health, so she established The Black Nurses Society of Greater Arlington during the pandemic. This nonprofit is a local independent organization committed to doing work in the community. She said, "Our mission and hearts' desire is to educate our community on the health care disparities that affect us. We make every effort to build, heal and not destroy. We are here to help and not hinder. This organization conducts health workshops to educate, does food drives, toy drives for Christmas, conducts a back-toschool rally and more.



Chiketa has been in the nursing field for 30 years, and her desire to help people continues to grow. "I carry on the legacy of our family of being kind, caring for people and going out of my way to do so," she concluded.

Prior to the late 1960s, these opportunities would not have been presented to her as an African-American woman, since it was against the law to be a nurse in diverse settings. Chiketa's parents were raised in the era of Jim Crow Laws. As a result, they were aware of the possibilities that became available to her because of the equality movement.

In order to take pride in their identity and strive for power on a local and national level, many Black Americans battled against racism and prejudice. Across the nation, there was a general feeling of hope, optimism and a commitment to improving the standard of living for Black people. While numerous civil rights organizations, such as the National Urban League and the NAACP had long been addressing the issue, the main catalyst that moved Black people from all walks of life and professions was the Civil Rights Movement. Today, we celebrate Chiketa Williams because she represents the accomplishments of African-Americans in the United States of America! NOW

#### **Funfetti Cookies**

1/2 cup unsalted butter

3/4 cup sugar

1 egg

 $1 \frac{1}{2}$  cups flour

1/2 tsp. baking powder

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/2 tsp. salt

- 1 tsp. cornstarch6 Tbsp. any type of sprinkles
- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 F.
- **2.** Put the butter in a microwave safe mixing bowl; microwave until the butter is halfway melted. Remove the bowl; whisk until completely melted.
- 3. Add the sugar to cooled butter; whisk

- until the butter absorbs the sugar. Add the egg; whisk until combined.
- **4.** Add the remaining ingredients, including the sprinkles; stir to combine with a wooden spoon or spatula.
- **5.** Refrigerate for at least 30 minutes and up to 2 days. Roll into 2-tablespoon-sized balls; place on a parchment lined baking sheet. Bake for 10 minutes.
- **6.** They may look undercooked, but they will be ready to serve after cooling.

#### **Lemon Velvet Cake**

Cake:

2 1/2 cups flour

I tsp. baking soda

1 tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. salt

1 3/4 cups sugar

3/4 cup canola oil

1/4 cup shortening

2 eggs

1-2 tsp. vanilla extract

1 Tbsp. pure lemon extract

I tsp. lemon zest

1 cup milk

1/2 tsp. white distilled vinegar

1/3 cup hot lemon water (hot water mixed with 2 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice)

4-6 drops yellow food coloring

Lemon Buttercream:

I cup butter, softened

4 cups powdered sugar Juice of 1 lemon

1 Tbsp. zest of lemon

1 Tbsp. milk (optional)

- **1.** For cake: Preheat the oven to 325 E. Thoroughly grease and flour 2 9-inch cake pans.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix the flour, baking soda, baking powder and salt; set aside.
- 3. In another large bowl, mix the sugar, oil and shortening. Mix in the eggs, one at a time.
- 4. Add the extracts and lemon zest. Alternately combine the dry ingredients and the milk into the wet ingredients. Mix the distilled vinegar and lemon water into the batter. Add the food coloring until the desired shade of yellow is reached. Pour the batter evenly into the prepared pans.
- 5. Bake for 25-30 minutes; cool.
- 6. For buttercream: Using a stand mixer, cream the butter using a paddle attachment on medium-high for 4-5 minutes, until light and fluffy. If necessary, halfway through, scrape the sides of the bowl and continue mixing.
- **7.** Slowly add the powdered sugar, lemon juice and lemon zest while mixing on low for 1 minute, until it incorporates and starts to look crumbly.
- 8. Turn up the speed; continue mixing on medium to high for 3-4 minutes until light and fluffy. If the frosting is too thick, you can add 1 Tbsp. of milk. If it is too thin, you can add another 1 or 2 Tbsp. of powdered sugar.
- 9. To assemble: Use a cake board covered with foil. Put a small smear of the buttercream on the cake board to help the first layer stick.
- 10. Flip the first cake pan upside down. Place on the cake board on top of the buttercream. Spread a layer of buttercream on top of the cake. Add the next layer along with more buttercream to cover the entire cake. Pipe on the top with 1m tip until complete.
