Small But Mighty

The Sunrise Rotary Club of Mansfield, Texas, may be small in size, but its impact is anything but. At the heart of the club's work is service, leadership and a deep commitment to the community. One of the driving forces behind that mission is the club's current president, Desiree Thomas, whose dedication to Mansfield spans more than two decades.

Originally from Nowata, Oklahoma, Desiree met her husband while attending the University of Oklahoma. His career eventually brought their family to the Arlington-Mansfield area of the DFW Metroplex. What began as a move for work, soon became a lifelong connection to Mansfield and a passion for serving the community they now call home.

Desiree began volunteering in 2001 as a stay-at-home mom, starting with the PTA even before her children were old enough to attend school. "I didn't even have kids in school yet," she recalled, "but I knew I needed to contribute to the community in some way." For Desiree, volunteering has always been about service and connection. She believes everyone needs a support system, and through volunteering, she built lasting friendships. She



credits much of that mindset to her grandmother, who was deeply involved in church and community service. "I believe she passed that on to me," she said.

Her involvement with the PTA eventually led her to take on an even larger role. "I worked on the PTA for so long that I decided to take the next step by serving on the school board for six years," she explained. "That way, I could help the community even more." Currently, she volunteers for the Texas PTA, representing North Texas at the state level.

Additionally, she spent many years pitching in at BIC (alternative school), which eventually changed its name to Phoenix Academy. She recalled how the school once supported students who were unable to continue their education in a traditional way at their home campuses because of their home environment or life circumstances. This helped them stay connected while completing their schooling. However, she noticed a different mindset when the school was renamed, describing the process as transformational. "It was a breath of fresh air," Desiree said. "The students needed encouragement, and the administrators and staff treated them like this was their first stop, not their last chance. The teachers were encouraging, supportive, helping the students feel valued and capable of success in a different way.

As she continued her journey of volunteering, the opportunity to lead the Sunrise Rotary Club of Mansfield presented itself, and she accepted. Rotary International is a global network of more than 1.2 million neighbors, friends, leaders and problem-solvers who see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change — across the globe, in communities and in themselves. Rotary members believe they have a shared responsibility to take action on the world's most persistent issues. There are more than 45,000 clubs working together to promote peace, fight disease,

provide clean water, sanitation and hygiene, improve maternal and child health, support education, grow local economies and protect the environment.

Desiree described the members of Sunrise Rotary as fun, collaborative, hands-on and purpose driven. "We all work together. I couldn't do it all by myself," she said. "Also, we assist other Mansfield nonprofits with programs like Feed the Kids. We focus on meeting needs within the community. The club brings together people of different ages and backgrounds who are united by a shared commitment to serve."

Sunrise Rotary supports a wide range of local and international projects. This includes Allies in Youth, scholarships for MISD students, service projects throughout Mansfield, Habitat for Humanity, mock interviews for students with special needs, judging district spelling bees and Rotary programs such as the Four-Way Speech Contest for high

school students. Internationally, the club helps fund the education of a young girl in Uganda. They began supporting her when she was around 9 years old, and now she has grown into an elegant, young woman whose future has been directly shaped by Rotary's support.

Some of the club's favorite volunteer efforts include the Friendship Ball, an annual event for children with special needs and their families. The event typically welcomes 70 to 80 children for an evening filled with music, dancing and celebration in a safe, joyful environment. The club has volunteered with Meals on Wheels for more than 20 years, delivering meals to seniors and checking in on their well-being, often becoming a familiar and welcome face for people who may not otherwise receive a visit from anyone.

"Sharing happiness is more fulfilling than receiving a paycheck, which is why I love volunteering," Desiree stated.

Rotary itself has evolved over time. Once limited to men, the organization opened its doors to women in the 1980s. Today, Desiree leads the Sunrise Rotary Club, and the group is intentional about developing future leaders. Vice President Sharon Sullivan is currently being mentored to step into leadership next, reflecting Rotary's focus on continuity and growth. Two of the original members, Randall Kennedy and Ralph Grimes, are still part of the club.

The Sunrise Rotary Club of Mansfield meets at Methodist Mansfield Medical Center and welcomes members who are serious about serving and community involvement. Rotary brings together business and community leaders to exchange ideas and take action to improve lives, strengthen relationships and build stronger communities both locally and around the world. As Desiree proudly put it, "The Club may be small, but it is truly mighty." **NOW**

Bringing Geyer Commons to Life: From Vision to Reality

The City of Mansfield celebrated the opening of a new community-focused gathering space known as Geyer Commons in February 2026. Designed to serve as the eastern gateway to Historic Downtown Mansfield, this project marks a milestone in the city's vision for a vibrant, connected downtown.

While the ribbon-cutting felt like the beginning, the project itself was several years in the making, forming part of a holistic approach to land use within Mansfield. The City Council was doing research as part of preparation to complete the updated Mansfield 2040 Land Use Plan. The land use plan had last been updated in 2012. With limited undeveloped land remaining and growth that was coming no matter what, the City Council made a point to visit several cities as case

studies, studying them for innovative ways to guide strategic development within Mansfield. "It's been very important to our City Council to both listen to residents and invest in smart growth that will support future generations," Mayor Pro Tem Todd Tonore said.

This research was paired with ongoing feedback from residents. Within the last four years, Community Satisfaction Surveys have continued to identify that residents desire more entertainment and gathering spaces within Mansfield. From parks to restaurants and retail, walkability was a repeated theme. At the same time, residents have continued to share that lowering taxes is important to them. "Mansfield residents have been asking for a third space like this, a location that's not work or home

but allows friends and family to come together," City Council member Juan Fresquez said. With Geyer Commons now open, I look forward to seeing residents and visitors alike creating lasting memories."

For the City Council, this combination of insights helped shape the path forward. It meant being thoughtful to come up with ways to both deliver the projects and amenities that residents want while also continuing to provide the noteworthy essentials that the community relies on. Projects like Geyer Commons are one example of how that vision began to take shape, creating a space that supports community gathering while also contributing to the long-term vitality of Historic Downtown Mansfield.

Phase 1A - Now Open

Phase 1A of the Geyer Commons, located at 605 E. Broad St. was completed in February and features a splash pad with programmable LED lighting, civic lawn space, and a cottage market for local entrepreneurs.

Phase 1 B

Phase 1B is currently in design, and is expected to feature the reconstruction of several key historic buildings including the Cumberland Church, Citizens Bank, and the Julian Feild House. Alongside the continued preservation of the original Mansfield High School and Rock Gym, this project will pay thoughtful homage to our history while making way for requested shopping, dining and retail options.

Future phases will also include a wiffle ball field as a nod to Geyer Field, alongside additional greenspace and needed parking improvements.

HOT CROSS BUNS

Easter Sunday brings families together around tables laden with time-honored dishes that have graced holiday celebrations for generations. These traditional recipes combine seasonal ingredients with cherished cooking techniques, creating meals that taste like springtime itself. **NOW**

Hot Cross Buns

Buns:

- 2 1/4 tsp. active dry yeast
- 1 cup warm milk
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg
- 1/4 tsp. ground allspice
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1/3 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 2 large eggs, beaten
- 3/4 cup raisins
- 1/2 cup dried currants
- 1/4 cup candied orange peel

Glaze:

- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2 Tbsp. milk

1. *For the buns:* Activate the yeast in warm milk with a pinch of sugar, letting it foam for about 10 minutes.
2. In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, remaining sugar, cinnamon, nutmeg, allspice and salt. Cut in the softened butter until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Stir in the eggs and the yeast mixture.
3. Knead the dough until smooth and elastic, approximately 10 minutes.
4. Fold in the raisins, currants and candied peel. After the dough doubles in size during its first rise, divide it into 12 equal portions, and shape them

into rounds. Arrange them on a baking sheet. Let them rise again.

5. Bake at 375 F until golden brown.

6. *For the glaze:* Combine the glaze ingredients. While the buns are still warm, pipe crosses on top using the glaze.

Glazed Ham With Mustard-Honey Coating

- 1 8- to 10-lb. bone-in ham
- 30-40 whole cloves
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup Dijon mustard
- 1/2 cup honey
- 2 Tbsp. apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 tsp. ground black pepper

1. Score the ham's surface in a diamond pattern, about 1/4-inch deep. Stud each intersection with a whole clove.
2. Place the ham in a roasting pan; tent with foil. Bake at 325 F, allowing 15 minutes per pound.
3. Meanwhile, combine the brown sugar, Dijon mustard, honey, apple cider vinegar and black pepper in a saucepan. Simmer until the mixture thickens slightly.
4. During the final hour of cooking, remove the foil and brush the ham generously with the glaze every 15 minutes, allowing each layer to caramelize before adding the next.

5. The finished ham should boast a magnificent mahogany crust that glistens invitingly.

Classic Deviled Eggs

- 12 large eggs
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tsp. Dijon mustard
- 1 tsp. white vinegar
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp. white pepper
- Paprika, for garnish
- 2 Tbsp. fresh chives, minced, for garnish

1. Place the eggs in a single layer in a saucepan. Cover the eggs with cold water by 1 inch; bring to a rolling boil. Remove from heat. Cover; let stand for 12 minutes.
2. Transfer to an ice bath immediately to stop cooking and ensure easy peeling.
3. Once cooled, peel the eggs carefully. Halve them lengthwise, and scoop the yolks into a bowl. Mash the yolks thoroughly with a fork. Blend in the mayonnaise, mustard, vinegar, salt and white pepper until completely smooth. Spoon or pipe the mixture back into the egg white halves, creating generous mounds. Finish with a light dusting of paprika and a sprinkle of minced chives for color and freshness.

What Is a Required Minimum Distribution?

A required minimum distribution (RMD) is the annual amount that generally must be withdrawn from a traditional IRA or a qualified retirement plan like a 401(k), 403(b) and self-employed plans, starting no later than April 1 of the year after the year the account owner reaches the age of 73. If you attained age 72 in 2022 or earlier, you are already required to take RMDs. The RMD age will rise to 75 in 2033. Some employer plans may allow still-employed account owners to delay distributions until they stop working, even if they are older than 73.

RMDs are designed to ensure that owners of tax-deferred retirement accounts do not defer taxes on their retirement accounts indefinitely. You are allowed to begin taking penalty-free distributions from tax-deferred retirement accounts after age 59 1/2, but you must begin taking them after reaching age 73. If you delay your first distribution to April 1 following the year in which you turn 73, you must take another distribution for that year. Annual RMDs must be taken each subsequent year no later than December 31.

The RMD amount depends on your age, the value of the retirement account and your life expectancy. You can use the IRS Uniform Lifetime Table to determine your life expectancy. To calculate your RMD, divide the value of your account balance at the end of the previous year by

the number of years you're expected to live, based on the numbers in the IRS table. You must calculate RMDs for each account that you own. If you do not take the required minimum distribution, a penalty of 25 percent will be assessed on the RMD amount that should have been taken, dropping to 10 percent if timely corrected by making up the missed RMD. "Timely" means corrected generally in two years (unless the penalty is assessed earlier). Of course, you can always withdraw more than the required minimum amount or even withdraw the entire balance as a lump sum.

Remember that distributions from tax-deferred retirement plans are subject to ordinary income tax. Waiting until the April 1 deadline in the year after reaching age 73 is a one-time option and requires that you take two RMDs in the same tax year. If these distributions are large, this method could push you into a higher tax bracket. It may be wise to plan ahead for RMDs to determine the best time to begin taking them. **NOW**

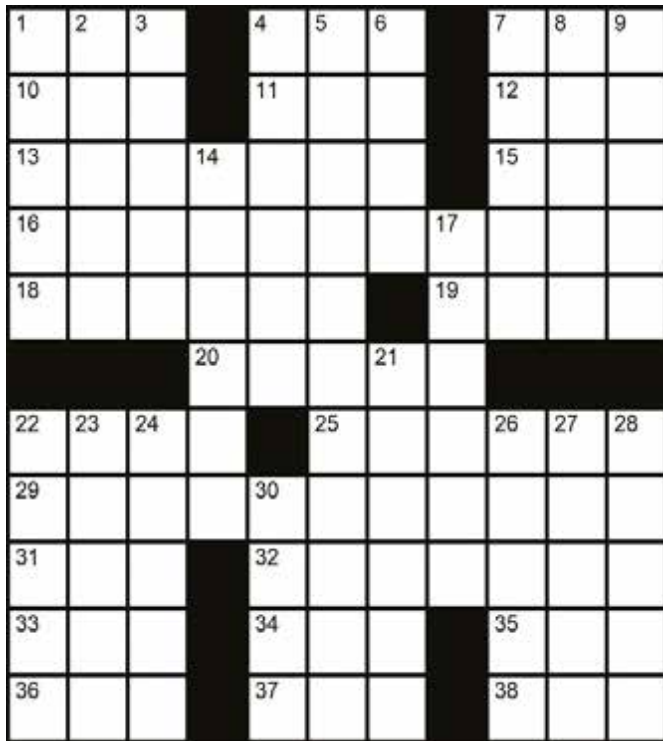

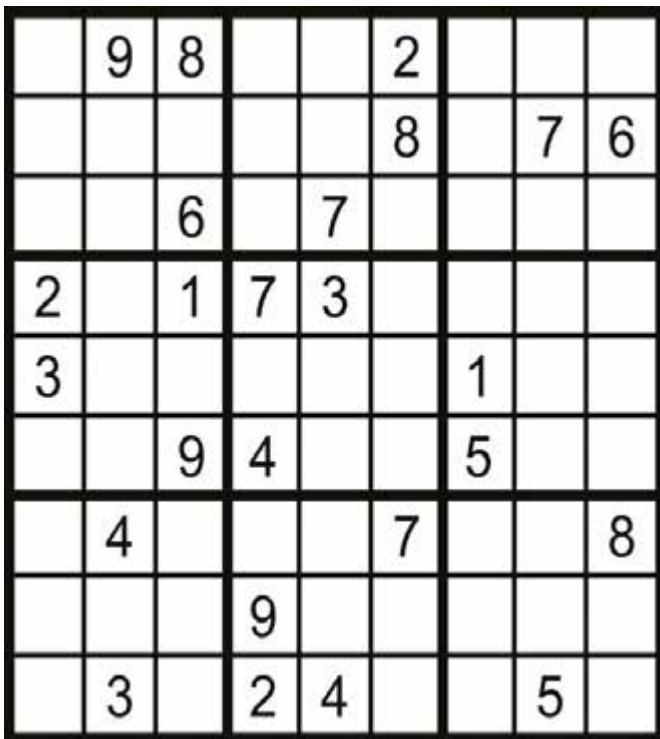

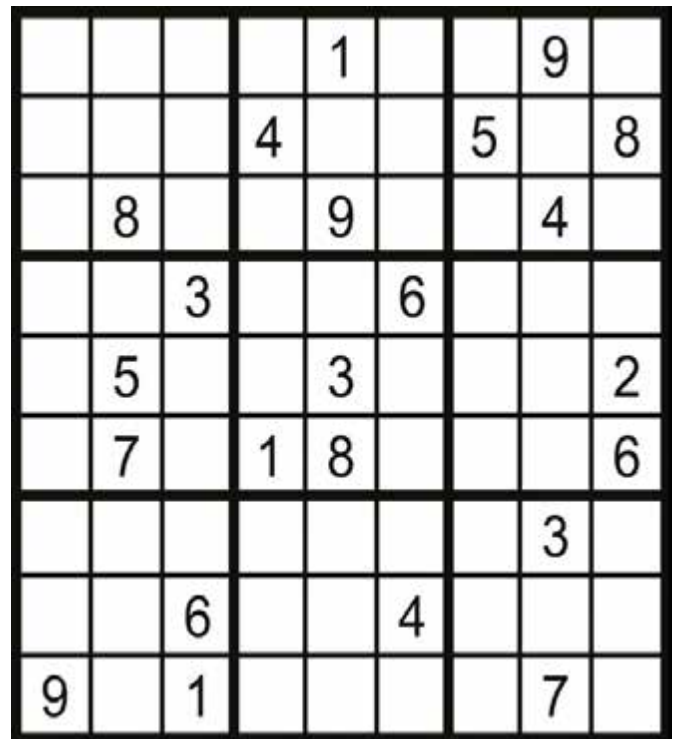
