





A journey that began in Mexico in the 1940s brought the ministers and founders of Templo Avivamiento to Corsicana. "We came because of God in 1974 when I was 27 years old. He wanted us here because of people with addictions and marriages in need of restoring," Pedro Aceves said. "At that time, there was only one Spanish speaking ministry in town at the Baptist church." Since then, Pedro and his wife, Gloria, have founded five churches, Templo Avivamiento in Corsicana, one in Dallas and three churches in Mexico.

Their busy lifestyle began while growing up in separate towns in Mexico. "My childhood was beautiful in Coyula, Guadalajara," Pedro recalled. "Everything was so organic and

healthy. I left my hometown for Laredo, Mexico, seeking funds for studies. I became a musician and worked at the international bridge."

Gloria grew up in Ciudad Acuña, Mexico, across the border from Del Rio, Texas. "I played a lot of cowboys and Indians when I was growing up, and I liked to sing," Gloria remembered. At age 17, Gloria met Pedro in Laredo and found they shared a love for God and music. "We got married, and God has blessed us with five boys, two who are pastors," Gloria added. "Joshua is the worship leader, youth pastor and associate pastor at Templo Avivamiento, and our other minister son is in Mexico. We lived in Laredo, and when our first two sons were small, we came to beautiful Corsicana. God has been good to us. We have beautiful sons, grandkids and great-grandkids and a beautiful congregation." As their ministry has grown, Pedro and Gloria's family has also grown. The couple has 14 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

With a family to support, Pedro and Gloria found employment in Corsicana quickly after their arrival. Pedro worked at several local companies, including Collin Street Bakery. Gloria opened the first taqueria in Corsicana, Taco



Laredo, in an old laundromat building and then bought the first food truck in Corsicana. "Lines were everywhere to get my mom's tamales," Josh Aceves recalled.

But the couple still had their journey's course set on the ministry and studies. They majored in theology at the International Theological University of Florida and began their church. Pedro has been the pastor, leader and mentor, and Gloria has been the preacher, janitor and singer. "Mom has always set up the ground floor work and worked hard," Josh said. "They did anything that had to be done, so now they do the more relaxing things needed. However, Mom picks up a mic every so often and sings and preaches."

"I have 10 recordings, and I like to sing even more now that I'm older," Gloria said.

The church has several outreach

programs involving the youth, with whom Josh works, feeding and clothing the homeless, adopting and cleaning streets and counseling. People find the Lord and even answer the call to ministry. "We have had many ministries come out of our congregation, with a few pastoring other churches in town," Josh remarked.

Over 45 years in ministry has introduced Pedro and Gloria to over 3,000 people in congregations. "We had about 250 members when God gave my father the vision like in that movie, 'Build it, and they will come," Josh stated. "We built this building for 1,000 people." Construction on the church facilities began in 2009.

Memories over the years abound. "The special programs we do, seeing families restored, people coming to the feet of Christ, the miracles of God. These are big blessings and memories," Gloria shared. The couple's musical talents have rubbed off on several family members who are now musicians in churches.

For both Pedro and Gloria, the people served have been their greatest joy in ministry. "The people and authorities in Corsicana are nice. Children behave in our church. There are a few tornadoes in Corsicana, but mostly it's peaceful here," Pedro said.

Gloria treasures having been able to raise her sons in Corsicana's peacefulness, security and in the same home for 30 years. When asked how she felt being the only lady in her house, Gloria's face instantly lit up. "I felt like a queen!" She admits her passion for mucho tacos and coffee. Still a great cook, she and Pedro now like to eat out at restaurants, especially those with buffets.

"The economy has been challenging, but God has backed us in everything we have built and brought the right people to us at the right time to bless this church," Pedro said. "We don't owe anyone on anything."

As one of the five boys growing up in Pedro and Gloria's household and church, Josh said, "Our household was very strict and very hard. My parents were always juggling family, ministering to others and the church. We were always under a microscope, even now. but God has been behind this whole life of ours. My parents have dedicated their entire life together with a passion to serve the Lord and His kingdom. They've been a blessing to countless families and people in this community."

"Having served the Lord for over 45 years has cost me in my health," Pedro related. "Ministry takes a toll on a body, but the rewards have overflowed. I have yet to see the full glory of what is to come."

Gloria agreed and concluded energetically, "There's more to come. Dios Es Bueno!" NOW



James' Black Bean Tacos With Mango Salsa

Makes 8-10 mini tacos.

Tacos:

1 15-oz. can black beans

I tsp. cilantro lime seasoning

l tsp. chili powder

1 tsp. garlic powder

1 tsp. cumin

1/2 tsp. salt

1 Tbsp. olive oil
1/2 cup Mexican-Blend cheese
8 small corn tortillas

Mango Salsa:

2 mango saisa:
2 mangoes, peeled and diced
1/2 medium red onion, diced
2 small sweet red peppers, diced
1 small jalapeño, diced
1/2 cup cilantro, chopped
luice of 1 lime

- **1.** For tacos: Drain and rinse the beans. In a small bowl, combine the beans and all the seasonings.
- **2.** In a small skillet, heat the olive oil over medium heat. Add the seasoned beans; cook until the beans are soft and heated completely.
- **3.** Removing the beans from the heat, mash them with a fork; add the cheese.
- **4.** Spread the bean mixture over each tortilla; fold the tortillas over. If the tortillas are stiff, warm them before use.
- **5.** Grill the tacos on a griddle or panini press or in a skillet until the outside is crispy and the cheese has melted.
- **6.** For salsa: In a small bowl, combine all the ingredients. The salsa can be served immediately or refrigerated before serving.

Codie's Cinnamon Apples in a lar

- 8-10 Granny Smith apples, washed, peeled and sliced
- I cup lemon juice
- 1 16-oz. pkg. cinnamon disc candies, crushed into fine pieces

2 cups sugar 2 cups water

- **I.** In a large bowl, place the apples in the lemon juice; add enough water to cover the apples; refrigerate overnight. Pack the apples into 2-qt. jars.
- **2.** In a saucepan, mix the cinnamon disc candies, sugar and 2 cups water; bring to a full boil. When the sugar is dissolved, pour the mixture over the apples.
- **3.** Add the jars' rings and lids. This recipe can be kept in the refrigerator or sealed using the water bath method.

Hearty Breakfast Muffins Makes 12 muffins.

Nonstick cooking spray

I lb. breakfast sausage

1/2 cup onion, diced

1/2 cup sweet yellow peppers, diced

1/2 cup sweet red peppers, diced

8 eggs

I Tbsp. Cajun seasoning 1/2 cup heavy cream or milk

- **1.** Preheat the oven to 375 F; spray a muffin tin with nonstick cooking spray.
- **2.** In a large skillet, brown the meat for about 3-5 minutes. Add the vegetables; continue cooking until browned. Set the meat mixture aside.
- **3.** In a bowl, beat the eggs, Cajun seasoning and cream or milk together well.
- **4.** Combine the egg mixture with the meat mixture; mix well. Pour the mixture into the muffin tin. Bake for 15-20 minutes until the eggs are set and the top is browned.






