



The Magic of PRESERVATION - By Amber D. Browne

The beauty of a hidden escape in the heart of Downtown Weatherford has appealed to visitors across the globe for more than 80 years. Once a cattle field, Chandor Gardens was transformed into a local treasure by the late Douglas Granville Chandor. His artistic vision led to the creation of a 3.5-acre oasis of various plant species, water features, a historic home that doubles as an event venue and so much more. Bill Warren, treasurer for the Chandor Gardens Foundation, has a passion for the gardens, as well as other historic sites across Parker County. And he is not afraid to share his passion for history with others.

Long before the Chandor Gardens Foundation — a 501 (c)(3) organization that works hand in hand with the city of Weatherford to operate and promote the venue — was founded in 2014, Bill shared with anyone listening about the beauty of the space. Bill is amazed by what Chandor, a portrait artist, was able to accomplish on the property. In 1936, Chandor blasted a caliche hillside with dynamite and transported in 6 feet of fill dirt for 3 acres of gardens. Stones from Parker County quarries created a waterfall and other stonework and water features across the property. "I find that fascinating that someone was so artistic and used his abilities in that way to bring such joy to people for years and years," Bill shared. "I'm still surprised at the number of people who live not only in Weatherford but in Parker County who don't know this place exists."

Chandor Gardens, known as White Shadows until it was renamed by Chandor's wife, Ina, following his death in 1953, provides a natural habitat for others to experience and enjoy. "The idea is to lose yourself up here," Bill explained. Divided into several smaller gardens featuring Oriental and Latin influences, Chandor Gardens is connected by pathways and waterways. Folklore is said to have been part of Chandor's design process. "Part of the Oriental culture is to stay out of the way of the Devil, you're not supposed to have long straight lines anywhere," Bill explained. "He meant for you not to be able to see the person in the garden next to you. You'll hear a voice, but you won't necessarily see the person. It's the magic about it that I think fascinates people."

Thanks in part to Ina's marketing skills, in the 1950s, Chandor Gardens was the only garden west of the Mississippi River (except along the West Coast) included in national gardening books. "It's like this oasis in the middle of North Texas. You do not expect this kind of greenery and plant architecture in the middle of Texas." Visitors can tour the gardens year-round, and they travel from across the world to experience the site, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The historic home doubles as a wedding venue and features copies of portraits painted by Chandor.

"I'm impressed with what Douglas and Ina accomplished here," Bill shared. He often walks the grounds and ponders how they accomplished such an extravagant feat, which is now part of history.

Bill is passionate about promoting and preserving heritage. He came by his love of history honestly. His mother, Betsy Warren, was an artist and illustrator of children's history books, including *Young Pioneers in Texas*. "History teaches us how we should live today," Bill shared. "I think it's important to understand what our forebearers accomplished without the machinery and without the technology."






Various historical projects across the local area are always at the top of Bill's to-do list. In addition to Chandor Gardens, he volunteers with the Parker County Heritage Society and the Parker County Historical Commission. He considers himself a preservationist and encourages others to appreciate the architecture of days past. "It's astounding to me the bravery, the courage, the faith in the future, what you can see when you go visit these places. That is what history attempts to try to tell us. Look around and soak up the beauty of it."

A new preservation project at the front of Bill's efforts with the Parker County Heritage Society is the Comte Paul de Bresson Stable, which is owned by Weatherford College. Previous projects include the addition of fencing around the perimeter of Old City Greenwood Cemetery, as well as the restoration of vandalized tombstones there.

With the Parker County Historical Commission, an arm of state government appointed by the Parker County Commissioners Court, Bill is working to preserve a truss bridge across the Brazos River. "It's the only truss bridge and the last of the historic bridges in Parker County. It's also on the National Register of Historic Places," he shared. "We've got to think of some way of preserving that bridge. It's a beautiful piece of work."

As president of the Abandoned Cemetery Association of Parker County, Bill and other volunteers care for nearly 80 abandoned cemeteries in the local area. Some of these cemeteries are upkept by property owners, while





volunteers mow, remove brush and repair fences at others.

At Chandor Gardens, Bill will continue to share his love of the property with those who are willing to listen and work with the city of Weatherford on future renovations. Plans are to add a parking lot and construct buildings on additional acreage that is part of the original 17-acre plot of land owned by the Chandors. Chandor took steps to bring his vision to life in 1936, and his vision still stands today, bringing joy to those who take the time to wander the winding paths. "What the man accomplished is phenomenal in the era and the place where he chose to do this. It's just fascinating to me." With the help of Bill and other local volunteers. Chandor Gardens and other historical sites across Parker County will continue to showcase the efforts of those long past. NOW

Sharing creative dishes with others is just one reason Linda Kline enjoys cooking. "To me, the best visiting happens around the table," Linda said. With her mother's help, Linda started baking at 12 and continued her culinary educational journey into adulthood following her adult daughter's teenage diagnosis with celiac disease. "It made me so happy to be able to fix our daughter's favorite foods and have her friends over, and they didn't even realize they were eating gluten-free unless we talked about it."

This longtime Weatherford resident, who serves on the Friends of the Weatherford Public Library board and as co-founder of the Parker County Bridal Fair, learns new recipes from cookbooks and gluten-free cooking classes. She now teaches her 5-year-old grandson a few new and inherited favorites. Now

Chuck Wagon Cheeseburger Skillet With Gluten-Free Drop Biscuit Topping

Beef Mixture:

- 1 lb. lean ground beef
- 3 Tbsp. onion, chopped (optional)
- 3 Tbsp. oil
- 2 1/2 cups frozen hash brown potatoes, thawed
- 1 11-oz. can Green Giant Mexicorn, drained
- 1 4-oz. can green chilies
- 1/2 cup gluten-free Kraft Original Barbecue Sauce
- 2 cups cheddar cheese, shredded 1/4 tsp. salt (optional)

Pepper, to taste (optional)

Biscuit Topping:

- **1.** For beef mixture: Preheat the oven to 400 F. In a skillet on medium heat, brown the ground beef and onion, if desired, until the beef is thoroughly cooked. Drain; set aside.
- **2.** Heat the oil in a skillet on medium heat. Add the hash brown potatoes; cook until lightly browned, about 3-5 minutes. Add the cooked ground beef, Mexicorn and the next 3 ingredients. Add salt and pepper, if desired; mix well. Pour the mixture into a greased baking dish.
- **3.** For biscuit topping: In a medium bowl, add the Pamela's Pancake and Baking Mix. Cut in the shortening until the baking mix is crumbly. Add the water; stir until combined. Drop by the spoonful on top of the casserole. Bake at 400 F for 16-24 minutes, or until desired brownness.

Vegetable Lasagna

Nonstick cooking spray 16 oz. 2% ricotta or cottage cheese 1/2 cup Parmesan, grated

I cup spinach, chopped

I cup carrots, chopped

1 cup zucchini squash, chopped

- I cup bell pepper, deseeded and chopped
- 9 gluten-free lasagna noodles, uncooked (divided use)
- 3 cups gluten-free pasta sauce (divided use)
- 8 oz. mozzarella cheese (divided use)
- **1.** Preheat the oven to 350 F. Grease an 11x8-inch glass casserole dish. In a large bowl, combine the ricotta or cottage cheese and Parmesan.
- **2.** In a separate bowl, combine the spinach and the next 3 ingredients.
- **3.** In the greased casserole dish, place three uncooked noodles. Cover with 1 cup pasta

sauce, 1/3 of the cheese mixture, 1/3 of the vegetables and 1/3 of the mozzarella. Repeat the process two more times. Cover tightly with foil; bake for 1 hour.

Easy Gluten-Free Chocolate Mayonnaise Cake

Cake:

Nonstick cooking spray

2 cups gluten-free flour blend

1 cup sugar

1 1/2 tsp. baking soda

1 1/2 tsp. baking powder

4 Tbsp. cocoa

1 cup water

1 cup mayonnaise

2 tsp. vanilla

Chocolate Icing:

1 cup sugar


1/4 cup cocoa

1/4 cup milk

2 Tbsp. butter


1 tsp. vanilla

- **1.** For cake: Preheat the oven to 350 F. Spray an 11x7-inch glass baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. In a large bowl, sift the flour blend and the next 4 ingredients. Add the remaining ingredients; beat until smooth. Pour the batter into the baking dish: bake for about 30 minutes, or until done. Set aside to cool.
- **2.** For chocolate icing: In a saucepan on medium-high heat, add the sugar and the next 3 ingredients. Bring to a boil for 1 minute, stirring frequently. Remove from heat; stir in the vanilla. Beat until the icing is thick enough to spread. Quickly spread the icing onto the cake before it sets.






