EDITOR'S NOTE


Here's to a somewhat normal!

CRATIVE ORAS - By Virginia Riddle

A photo of antique brick in downtown Corsicana overlaid with images of flowers and old, handwritten notes appears in one of Sharon Golston's latest online creations. "I find digital art to be most satisfying at the moment, as I can produce works of art using photos I've taken and can manipulate them using photo apps to get a variety of results I love," Sharon explained. "I seek out timeworn patinas and often photograph buildings or barns that have been deserted."

A Denton, Texas, native, Sharon and her husband, Bill Golston, moved to Corsicana in 2016. "Corsicana's a little oasis drawing artists from around the world who seek a peaceful environment to produce their works of art and a place with few, if any, distractions coming from the corporate environment of big cities," Sharon shared.

Her preparation as an artist began early in life. "I had to entertain myself for most of my childhood. My parents were older and didn't want to do much in the way of entertainment," she remembered. It was while in college at The University of Texas at Arlington that she began exploring art in its many forms. There she earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. "The first person to recognize my talent was a professor of photography, who encouraged me to get my master's in photography," Sharon explained.

She's worked in watercolor, oils, acrylics and photography. "With watercolor, minimal and quick brush strokes can produce a beautiful work of art," Sharon explained. "With oil or acrylic, I can take my time and change areas with little problem. Now, I'm finding digital art to be most satisfying." With an artist's eye, she composes her digitally enhanced photos and photo collages.

A skilled photographer with a vast collection of photographs, Sharon uses her extensive computer skills and creative apps, while still applying the skills she has used in other art mediums: perspective, composition, choosing a focal point, shadow and light and color enhancement. She can create a "painting" from a photograph, making the photograph look more realistic, minimalistic or abstract. "I like to see beyond what is considered ordinary and recreate it to be extraordinary. I look at each photo, download it into the app and use whatever app method to make the photo spark the imagination or recreate a memory — a place in time or a dream," Sharon revealed. "I consider many areas of life a palette such as landscaping, interior design and fashion. I use my camera to capture the essence of a subject."

Her work has been shown in a UTA art gallery and at the Warehouse Living Arts Center Gallery. Every gallery showing is memorable, but Sharon added, "Passing a jury of my artwork at UTA was also memorable because it allowed me to graduate!" She cited Gladys Epperson, the Corsicana Art League president, as a mentor. "Gladys invited me to exhibit my work at the WLAC," she said.

Even before COVID-19 closed galleries in the spring of 2020, Sharon displayed her art and vintage jewelry in her online shops, and she advertises through social media. Creating ads for her work is another gratifying and creative process for her. She enjoys being a business owner while being able to express herself creatively and helping with family finances. During COVID days, Sharon saw opportunity. "An artist has a rich inner life that is a buffer to the real world," she believes.

To aspiring artists, Sharon advises, "Dig deep into your soul and what you want to convey to others. What really matters is if your work speaks to you. Don't be afraid to listen to your own drummer."

She enjoys spending time with family and friends and her two cats, Max and Mia. "My occupation is my avocation, but I'm also an avid gardener — now by proxy since I'm using a yardman," Sharon admitted. This artist is proud of her yard, "It's wonderful when I'm told that my landscaping is very creative," she added.

Sharon attends Northside Baptist Church, where she sings in the choir, volunteers with the children's programs and helps provide food for the sick or bereaved. "We live in a town with people who care about their neighbors and would help in any situation," she said. Sharon is an active member of Community Bible Study, Corsicana Newcomers Club, the Better Gardens Club and the Corsicana Art League.

For Sharon, life in Corsicana is very inspiring and agreeable. The century old buildings downtown with boutiques and restaurants were unique attractions for her and Bill when looking to relocate, and they often serve as backgrounds in Sharon's photography. She shared, "In a time of cookie-cutter strip malls that permeate most large cities, I walk down the sidewalks on either side of cobbled streets and am greeted by shop owners who often know my name. Friends gather for coffee or lunch at restaurants and various eateries that provide comfort food and gourmet cuisine. We're living in the best place possible." NOW



If you live in Texas but not under a rock, you no doubt have heard the name Willie Nelson, if not also his numerous charttopping country hits. One of the most recognized crooners in country music, Willie marked his 88th birthday this year.

Born April 29, 1933, in Abbott, Texas, Willie Hugh Nelson grew up not only to be a musician, but also an actor and activist. He received his first guitar at age 6 and sold his first song for \$50.

As a teen, Willie performed with Bud Fletcher and the Texans in area honky-tonks. He played the local circuit until graduation in 1950, when he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force. Chronic back problems led to an honorable discharge within a year, and Willie enrolled in Baylor University's farming program.

Working as a disc jockey, Willie's heart was still in music. He ultimately abandoned his studies, leaving Waco for Nashville. He first gained recognition in his 30s, writing notable songs such as "Crazy" for Patsy Cline and "Night Life" for Ray Price. By the 1970s, a series of original releases saw little commercial success but resulted in a loyal fan base. He partnered with country star Waylon Jennings, and the duo developed a genre best known as "outlaw country," mimicking Willie's own lifestyle.

1970 was also the year Willie's Tennessee home burned down, but that loss was Texas' gain. He moved back to Texas and became a staple of Austin's burgeoning music scene.

Willie's first two albums following his Texas return did not chart well, and his bandana-wearing, braided-hair persona belied his professional skill as a performer. 1975 would change that, when Willie's ironically titled album, Redheaded Stranger, made him a stranger to no one.

Songs like "Blue Eyes Crying in the Rain" crossed over from country to pop charts, and it was said that Willie appealed to vast audiences by blending not just country and pop, but also blues, folk, jazz, swing and more. "Blue Eyes Crying in the Rain" would be his first No. 1 hit, earning a GRAMMY Award for best country vocal performance.

In 1978, Willie would take home the GRAMMY for best country vocal performance by a duo with Waylon Jennings on "Mammas Don't Let Your Babies Grow Up to Be Cowboys," and his cover of "Georgia On My Mind" earned him a second "best country vocal" GRAMMY.

To further show his diversity, Willie took to the big screen in 1979's The Electric Horseman, earning an Academy Award nomination for best original song with "On the Road Again." From 1980 to 2018, he held some 48 additional roles in TV and film, including the screen adaptation of Redheaded Stranger in which he played the Reverend Julian Shay.

In 1982, another best country vocal performance GRAMMY was his with "Always on My Mind." Then "To All the Girls I've Loved Before" — Willie's duet with Julio Iglesias — resulted in international acclaim. In 1985, Willie again partnered with Waylon Jennings, along with Johnny Cash and Kris Kristofferson, to form the country group, the Highwaymen, which went on to some commercial success.

In 1985, Willie partnered with performers Neil Young and John Cougar Mellencamp for the first Farm Aid concert, raising nearly \$10 million to help family farmers keep their land. The program continues to assist farmers and led to Willie's induction into the National Agricultural Hall of Fame.

Willie is known for his animal activism and being a proponent of green fuel. He has also long touted the benefits of cannabis, and his company, Willie's Reserve, has grown and sold marijuana products in states where it is legal since 2015.


Because of his well-recognized, laid-back persona, Willie has often been called on for cameos such as that in 1999's Austin Powers: The Spy Who Shagged Me and larger roles like Uncle Jesse in 2005's The Dukes of Hazzard. He also voiced himself in cameo appearances on popular animated shows such as The Simpsons and King of the Hill.

Living the lyrics of his songs, Willie developed a reputation as a bit of an outlaw and landed himself in trouble a few times in his life. But loyal fans of the beloved Texan helped him through those times.

Willie continues to tour and perform to a variety of acclaim, including a 2008 GRAMMY for the single "Lost Highway," performed with Ray Price, the singer for whom Willie had penned one of his earliest successful songs. He has collaborated with the likes of Cyndi Lauper, Sheryl Crow and Snoop Dogg in more recent years, and his career totals 94 studio albums including solos, collaborations, compilations and soundtracks.



Too hot to exercise outside in this Texas heat and humidity? Come inside Anytime Fitness' cool comfort and meet owner, Chris Persilver, or manager, Faith Heath, who live by the gym's

motto, "Let's Make Healthy Happen." Chris stated, "I love working with members while helping to build them up. Their fitness journey is important. I enjoy watching members grow physically and mentally."

Anytime means access is available 24/7, so members can schedule workouts around their other time demands. During first time visits, new members receive a fitness consultation or a personal training session and a body scanner session. "Members can choose to wait until later for the personal training session, but the body scanner is a must," Chris explained. "It helps us and members keep track of progress." The body scanner gives readings that include body-fat percentage to lean mass to water weight.

The gym's exercise equipment, less than two years old, includes treadmills, a StairMaster, a rowing machine, bikes, ellipticals and arc trainers. Selectorized weight machines include leg extension, leg curl, abductor and adductor and a cable

station. There's a 14-foot perimeter rack to bench press, squat and power clean. Dumbbells up to 100 pounds, barbells for everyday use and competition-style lifting, a leg press and Smith Machine, along with adjustable benches, make it possible for everyone to find what works for them.

New members can choose one- or two-year agreement plans. Individual fee-based workouts can be scheduled with a personal trainer when members need more motivation. Want a little social, fun time? That's available, too, with scheduled small-group sessions. "Faith is amazing!" Chris stated. "She conducts the personal training, coaching and small group training sessions." Even shirts, water bottles and energy drinks are available for purchase. Anytime Fitness accepts checks, credit/debit cards, cash and some health insurance plans as payment.

"Our Anytime Fitness family is amazing!" Chris exclaimed. "I don't like calling members, members. They're truly my family, and they have stepped up to help me in more ways. I'm still on active duty with the Texas Army National Guard, so I can't always be there. Members bring joy to my heart. I love the way our town supports the local businesses and how Corsicana is continuing to grow."

Chris, a Mildred High School graduate, joined the National Guard at 17. "Fitness is a huge part of military life," he said. He started lifting weights as a young teen. "I planned a gym while in high school," Chris added. "I still have the sketches and designs. Fitness isn't a competition with others. It's about competing with yourself to get better. Our gym members and staff encourage each other."

He holds a bachelor's degree in religion and has attended Baylor University's Truett Theological Seminary and the Dallas Theological Seminary. Chris said, "If I'm walking right with God, my fitness regime is on point. At Anytime Fitness, we're striving to be the best gym around," Chris remarked. "We lift heavy and hard and encourage our members to reach their goals. We never quit — never ever."

2 tsp. salt

1 tsp. cinnamon

6 cups oatmeal

1 1/2 cups blueberries

Topping:

1 cup powdered sugar 1/4 cup milk

1 Tbsp. maple syrup

1/2 tsp. cinnamon

- **1.** For oatmeal: Mix all the ingredients, except the oatmeal and blueberries. Fold in the oatmeal; mix well.
- **2.** Gently stir in the blueberries. Pour the batter into a greased 9x13-inch pan; refrigerate overnight.
- **3.** In the morning, bake the oatmeal at 350 F for 30 minutes. Remove from the oven; cut into pieces.
- **4.** For topping: In a bowl, combine all the ingredients; serve on the side.

Easy-peasy Banana Bread

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 8-oz. pkg. cream cheese
- 2 eggs
- I cup bananas, or pumpkin (fall season) or fruit of choice
- 2 cups Low Fat Bisquick Mix, or any all-purpose baking mix
- **1.** In a bowl, cream together the sugar and cream cheese. Add the eggs and fruit; stir in the baking mix.
- **2.** Pour the batter into a greased bread pan. Bake at 350 F for 1 hour, covering the pan with foil after 45 minutes to keep the top from getting too brown.

Vegan Strawberry Frozen Yogurt

This cool, refreshing recipe tastes great in Texas' hot summers.

- 4 cups frozen strawberries
- 3 Tbsp. honey
- 1/2 cup plain or vanilla Silk Dairy-Free yogurt
- 1 Tbsp. lemon juice
- **1.** In a blender or food processor, mix all the ingredients for about 5 minutes, or until the mixture is smooth.
- **2.** Serve immediately, or the yogurt may be stored in the freezer.

Chewy Cake

1/4 cup water
2 egg whites
Cooking spray
Whipped cream, to taste
Blueberries, to taste
Strawberries, or any other preferred berries





- **1.** In a bowl, combine the cake mix, sugar, water and egg whites. With a baggie sprayed with cooking spray and put over one hand, spread the dough evenly over a greased jelly roll pan, spreading to the edges of the pan.
- 2. Bake for 18 minutes at 350 F. Remove the cake from the oven; let it cool completely.
- **3.** Top with the whipped cream, blueberries and strawberries to create a flag design.

Raspberry Vegan Shortbread

Shortbread:

2 1/2 cups flour

3/4 cup sugar

1/2 tsp. salt

I cup coconut oil, softened but not melted 13 oz. raspberry preserves

Glaze:

1/2 cup powdered sugar 2 Tbsp. almond milk

- 1. Preheat the oven to 300 F. Line the bottom and sides of a 9x13-inch baking pan with parchment paper, leaving some paper hanging over the edges for easy removal from the pan.
- 2. For shortbread: In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar and salt; mix well. Add the coconut oil; using hands, mix until the

dough becomes crumbly.

- **3.** Set aside 1 cup of the shortbread dough; press the remaining dough evenly into the pan. Bake for 15 minutes. Remove the shortbread from the oven: turn the temperature to 350 E.
- **4.** Spread the raspberry preserves over the warm crust. Sprinkle on the cup of shortbread you set aside in step 3.
- **5.** For glaze: Combine the ingredients; add the glaze to the cool cake before serving.

Grilled Shrimp With Mango Salsa

This is best served with rice.

Salsa:

2 mangoes, peeled and cut into small bites

1/4 cup purple onion, diced

1 Tbsp. jalapeño pepper, seeded, minced

1 Tbsp. cilantro, chopped

1 Tbsp. apple cider vinegar

I tsp. honey

I tsp. cumin

Garlic, to taste

Salt. to taste

Pepper, to taste

Shrimp Marinade:

2 Tbsp. cilantro, chopped



2 Tbsp. lime juice 1/4 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. chili powder

1 1/2 lbs. shrimp, peeled, deveined

- 1. For salsa: In a bowl, mix all the ingredients well. Cover; refrigerate for at least 1 hour.
- 2. For shrimp: In a glass bowl, mix all the ingredients well. Cover; refrigerate and marinate for several hours.
- **3.** Prepare a grill; place the shrimp in a single layer on a grill pan or on skewers. Grill for 1 1/2 to 2 minutes per side.

It's that time of year when we are all getting a little antsy for a vacation. Tyler, Texas, and its surrounding area is an ideal choice for a weekend trip, or longer, where families or couples can create delightful memories without a long car ride or plane trip. Tyler is only a couple-hour drive from the Metroplex and offers a plethora of fun and interesting things to see and do in an area filled with history, art, music, food, recreational opportunities and botanical wonders.

Camp Ford is located just 3 miles outside Tyler and easily captures the imagination of Civil War buffs and children alike. It was the largest Confederate POW camp west of the Mississippi. There is a short walking path with signs explaining about the camp and a cabin reconstruction that depicts life in the camp, which held captive more than 5,000 American Union soldiers.

The park is open every day from dawn to dusk, and admission is free. If you enjoy picnicking, there is also a lovely, little shady picnic area in the park.

For those interested in learning about endangered wildlife, one of the best big cat sanctuaries in the U.S. is located just outside Tyler's city limits. The 150-acre preserve, Tiger Creek Wildlife Refuge, has been caring for and rehabilitating neglected and abandoned tigers for more than 25 years. Recently, the refuge expanded its reach to include other wild cats such as lions, cougars and servals, as well as large birds and other formerly homeless wild animals. Guided tours are given daily for those who want to learn more about saving these magnificent creatures.

No trip to Tyler would be complete without taking time to

see the iconic Tyler Rose Gardens. At 14 acres, it is the largest rose garden in the United States. Walk along the paths, and enjoy row after row of beautiful roses, labeled to help visitors find a favorite variety to grow themselves. Spend time at the reflecting pools and peaceful water fountains, and learn about native plants and perennials in the beautifully landscaped, cottage-style Idea Garden.



For those adventurous souls, about 10 miles outside of Tyler is the opportunity to zipline! The company, New York, Texas ZipLine Adventures, has been in business for 10 years and offers zipline escapades for everyone over the age of 5. They offer a 1 1/2-hour or a 2-hour course, all set in the peaceful, scenic landscape of East Texas. Find out everything about them at goziptexas. com, or check them out on Facebook.

The choices for staying overnight in the Tyler area are endless. They have multitudes of hotels, bed-and-breakfasts, cottages, cabins and RV parks. The Tyler State Park is a true gem. It offers not only 83 campsites, but also five cabins and 28 screened shelters for rent. The park has something to do for every kind of nature lover. Bird blinds, mountain-bike trails, fishing piers, hiking trails, watercraft rentals and wildlife viewing are just some treasures found in this awesome state park.

It is easy to see that finding something amazing to do is not difficult in the Tyler area. It's the perfect choice for those who want to get away but don't want to spend a lot of time driving. Have fun!




