THE PRESIDENT'S DRIVER

Ferdinand "Speedy" Gonzales grew up on the westside of San Antonio, Texas, in a neighborhood where choices were limited. The environment was tough. "I knew if I stayed, I might end up in a gang," he stated. "And, back then, life followed a simple pattern. Sons did what their fathers did. That's just how it was." So after graduating high school, he stepped into a factory job, just like his father. But it didn't take long for him to realize it wasn't the life he wanted.

"I remember thinking, *There is no way I'm going to spend years in this hot factory,*" he said. That day after work, without overthinking it, he made a decision that would change everything. He walked straight to the United States Air Force Recruiting Office and enlisted. Once people learned the news, his whole family, the neighborhood — *everyone* — was excited for him. They were proud. It meant something to serve the country. The Air Force gave him a way out, and his first assignment took him to Alaska.

However, he wasn't the first in his family to serve. "My oldest brother started it," he said. "He created the legacy, and it grew. We now have a large number of family members who serve or have served, including nieces and nephews. Together, we have served the United States of America for 247 years."

Speedy began working in the Air Force Sports Department, helping pilots recover physically so they could return to duty. In that department, they provided massages and exercises to help many servicemen recover.

"I helped get them back into shape," he said. "That was my job." But the Air Force had more in store for him than he ever imagined. "I had no idea the kind of opportunities I would get. Never in my life did I think I'd live a life like this."

One day, he received a call. "The officer asked me, 'Do you want to be the driver for Vice President Lyndon Baines Johnson (LBJ) when he comes to Texas?' And I didn't hesitate. I replied, 'Yes.' I was thrilled." Soon, Speedy found himself among a line of drivers — Corvettes polished, uniforms crisp — waiting for President John F. Kennedy and Vice President Johnson's arrival. "We were all ready," he recalled. "Cars lined up, drivers in place. We were just waiting. Then a serviceman began walking down the line, speaking quietly to each driver. When he got to me, he said, 'He isn't coming. The president has been assassinated.'"

a quick visit, but there was so much to learn — protocol, expectations, everything,” he said. “That *quick visit* turned into five years. Every time the president came to the ranch, being his driver was my assignment.”

One memory stood out. “During our first Christmas, President Johnson invited all of the servicemen over to the house for cookies and chocolate late at night.” He smiled at the memory. “LBJ even wore his suit — out of respect for us. He was incredibly kind.”

During those years, Speedy witnessed history up close. “I saw the president almost daily. “Met senators, movie stars, all kinds of important people. And, of course, Lady Bird Johnson. She was as kind as you’d imagine.” Some of those encounters turned into friendships. Others became stories he still carries today. He even traveled with the president to Mexico to interpret for him.

In 1969, Speedy returned to his original role of working with pilots. After 24 years in the Air Force,

he retired and later became an insurance salesman. “I lived a simple life,” he remarked. “A good life.” Among his most treasured items is a United States Air Force Combination Medal awarded to him by the president and a pen the president used to sign a bill. “That meant a lot. I’ve got memorabilia — cigarette lighters from flights, things like that,” he said. “Pieces of history.”

Then, he pointed at a picture on the wall and said, “These are all of the servicemen who served when LBJ became president, and I’m the only one still living from that group to tell the story. Over the years, people have encouraged me to write a book. They say, ‘You’ve seen history. You should tell your story.’” He smiled at the idea. “Maybe one day,” he said. Stories like his aren’t just personal. They’re part of something bigger. A reminder that, sometimes, all it takes is one decision — one walk out of a factory — to change the course of your life. And, in Speedy’s case, to step into history. **NOW**

Silence. “We didn’t know what to say,” Speedy remembered. “The words didn’t register at first. We were stunned. Nobody spoke. We just got in our cars and drove back.”

Two weeks later, another call came. “They told me to report to the base protocol officer,” he said. Then came the question: “Do you want to serve for President Lyndon B. Johnson at the ranch?” He answered the same way he always did. “I said, ‘Yes.’ I didn’t even know what I was getting into.”

The Christmas of 1963 marked the beginning of a new chapter: serving President Lyndon B. Johnson. “It was

Mansfield Dedicates the Veterans Memorial at Julian Feild Park

The City of Mansfield officially dedicated the Veterans Memorial at Julian Feild Park during a Memorial Day weekend ceremony.

Located at 1531 E. Broad St., the memorial is part of the redevelopment of Mansfield's first park. The project reflects a long-standing City Council vision to create a place where residents can honor the service and sacrifice of veterans while preserving an important piece of Mansfield's history.

"Mansfield has always been a community that takes great pride in honoring those who have served our country," Mayor Michael Evans said during the dedication ceremony. "This memorial is more than a park. It is

a lasting commitment to remembering the sacrifices of our veterans and ensuring future generations understand the cost of freedom."

Improvements include the Veterans Memorial Plaza, renovated Serenity Gardens, new landscaping, sidewalks, restrooms and gathering spaces throughout the park. The creek running through the park was converted into a reflecting pond, creating a new focal point while also addressing long-standing drainage concerns. New bridges improve access throughout the park, while an open event plaza and tiered seating create space for future community events and gatherings, like the annual Salute that is part of Veterans Day festivities.

The memorial was developed with input from the Mansfield Veterans Memorial and Tribute Foundation, whose members worked alongside City staff throughout the planning process. What began as an initial concept sketch evolved into a community landmark designed to recognize veterans from every branch of military service.

During the dedication, City leaders noted that creating a veterans memorial had been a priority for the City Council for several years. The memorial provides a permanent place for residents to recognize the sacrifices made by Mansfield veterans and their families, as well as preserve their stories.





Dedication Ceremony - May 2026

The improvements were funded through Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone No. 1 and represent a \$6.5 million investment.

Future phases of the park plan to include additional walking trails, scenic overlooks and a connection to the Walnut Creek Linear Trail system.

The Veterans Memorial at Julian Feild Park is now open to the public and serves as a place

for residents to gather, reflect and honor those who have served our nation.

Independence Day calls for outdoor gatherings filled with friends, family and festive foods that capture the spirit of summer. Whether you're hosting a backyard barbecue or heading to the park, these recipes can help make your Fourth of July picnic truly memorable. **NOW**

American Flag Fruit Cake

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 3 large eggs
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup whole milk

Frosting:

- 8 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup powdered sugar
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream

Decorations:

- 1 cup fresh blueberries
- 2 cups fresh strawberries, sliced

1. *For the cake:* Preheat the oven to 350 F; grease a 9x13-inch baking pan.
2. In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder and salt.
3. In a large bowl, beat the butter and sugar until light and fluffy.
4. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Stir in the vanilla.
5. Alternately add the flour mixture and milk to the butter mixture, beginning and ending with the flour.
6. Pour the batter into the prepared pan; bake for 25-30 minutes until a toothpick comes out clean. Let the cake cool completely in the pan.
7. *For the frosting:* In a medium bowl, beat the cream cheese and powdered sugar until smooth.

8. In a separate bowl, whip the heavy cream until stiff peaks form. Fold the whipped cream into the cream cheese mixture until well combined.

9. Spread the frosting evenly over the cooled cake.

10. *To decorate:* In the upper left corner, arrange the blueberries in a rectangle to create the "stars" section of the flag.

11. Arrange the sliced strawberries in horizontal rows across the rest of the cake to create the "stripes." Leave white frosting stripes between the strawberry rows to complete the American flag pattern.

12. Refrigerate for at least 1 hour before serving.

Classic BBQ Pulled Pork Sandwiches

- 2 Tbsp. brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp. paprika
- 1 Tbsp. garlic powder
- 1 Tbsp. onion powder
- 2 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. black pepper
- 4 lbs. pork shoulder
- 1 cup chicken broth
- 1 1/2 cups barbecue sauce of your choice
- 12 hamburger buns
- 2 cups coleslaw

1. In a small bowl, mix together the first 6 ingredients.
2. Rub the spice mixture all over the

pork shoulder, coating it completely.

3. Place the seasoned pork in a slow cooker; pour the chicken broth around it.

4. Cook on low for 8-10 hours until the meat is fork-tender and shreds easily.

5. Remove the meat from the slow cooker; shred it using two forks. Discard excess fat; return the shredded meat to the slow cooker.

6. Stir in the barbecue sauce; keep warm until ready to serve.

7. Toast the hamburger buns lightly if desired. Pile the pulled pork onto the bottom buns; top with coleslaw. Cover with the top buns; serve immediately.

Baked Beans

- 6 slices bacon, chopped
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 4 15-oz. cans navy beans, drained
- 1 cup ketchup
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup molasses
- 2 Tbsp. yellow mustard
- 1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce

1. Preheat oven to 350 F.
2. In a skillet, cook the chopped bacon until crispy; remove and set aside.
3. In the bacon drippings, sauté the onions until softened.
4. In a large baking dish, combine the beans, bacon and onions. Stir in the remaining ingredients.
5. Bake, uncovered, for 45-50 minutes until bubbly and slightly thickened.

No Investment Vacation!

Another school year has ended, and summer vacations are well underway. Sometimes, investors take time away from monitoring their investment portfolios while enjoying some well-earned time away from work. There are a few important things to keep in mind during the heat of summer to help you stay focused on your financial goals.

1. *Take a close look at your individual holdings and evaluate whether to sell, hold or buy more.* Now might be a good time to harvest some tax losses in preparation for your 2027 income tax bill. If you own investments that may not have the potential to recoup losses, consider selling those investments to offset potential capital gains before the end of the year. Or perhaps those holdings have just hit a slow spell, and fundamentals look good again. If so, consider adding money to take advantage of the potential recovery.

2. *If you and your advisor have established a specific asset allocation, make sure the allocation is still within the parameters of your plan.* If some investments have grown more quickly than others and caused your allocation to be off, take gains and add to investments that might be down in value.

3. *Re-evaluate your financial goals, and make adjustments to your portfolio if necessary.* Some things that might have affected your goals are a birth, death, marriage, divorce, graduation,

inheritance, sale or purchase of a business, changing or losing a job or retirement. Evaluation of your investments to make sure they align with your goals is important.

4. *As you grow older, age milestones are important to keep in mind as well.* When you turn 59 1/2, the early distribution penalty goes away for Traditional IRAs. Even though taking money from an IRA could result in additional income tax, there is no penalty. Also, the Internal Revenue Service requires minimum distributions from Traditional IRAs after the account holder turns 73. Consult your tax professional or financial advisor about taking your RMD. Waiting until the end of the year is not necessary.

5. *Evaluate your current household budget to see if you need to change the amount of income being taken from your portfolio.* If expenses have gone up or down, your financial advisor may be able to help you change some investments to accommodate those changes.

Just because you might be taking time off from work, make sure your investments don't go on vacation with you. Keep your money working in conjunction with your financial plan. 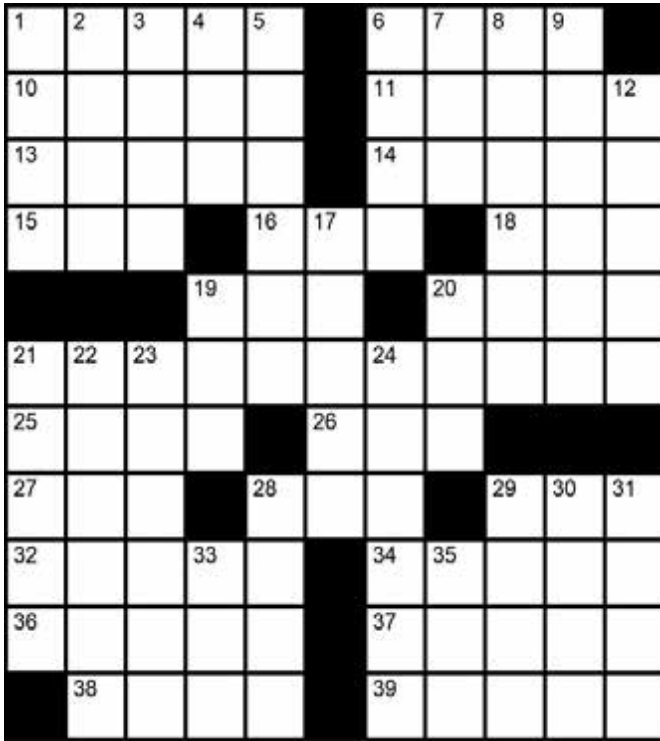

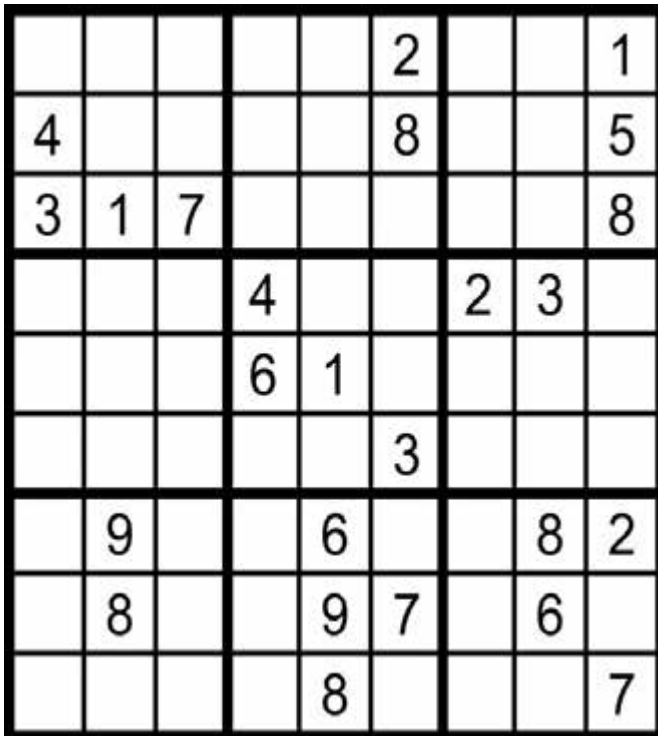

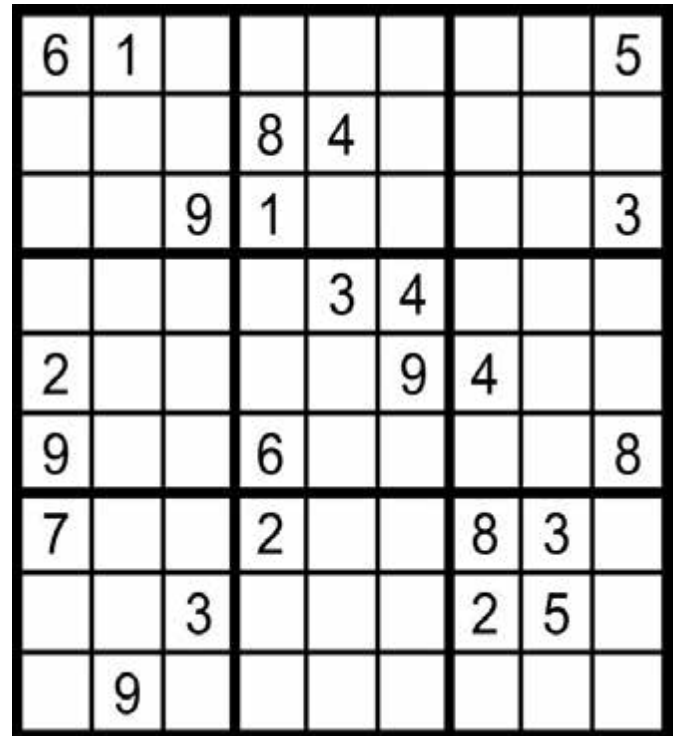
