





Retirement does not come easy for some always active and on-call professionals who are driven to respond to other's needs. When Dr. John Blewitt retired from ministry at Westminster Presbyterian Church in 2018 and completed an interim pastorate in 2021, he found he was "drifting along." However, his "drift" didn't last long. "I wasn't teaching or preaching," John recalled. But with time to read more, he focused on world issues — war, poverty, racism, environmental destruction, justice, win-win resolutions, transforming hurt and anger to healing, reconciliation and finding peace in one's heart. His reading and research led him to found Nonviolent Navarro in Fall 2022. "Being involved with this has been very freeing," he stated. "I have a wider audience."

John's wider audience also includes theater goers who have enjoyed his thespian talents on the Ennis Public Theatre's stage now that he has more time to devote to community involvement. Karen, his wife, had begun running the box office at the theater, and John joined her as a volunteer. He found he liked treading the boards, appearing first in *Young Frankenstein*. In his somewhat typecast roles, John has played Reverend Bass in *Walking Across Egypt*, Monsignor Ryan in *Guess Who's Coming to Dinner*, and also Scrooge in *A Christmas Carol*. His latest role was in the play, *I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change*, and involved comedy, singing and dancing. For some productions, he is part of the sound/light crew. "Sharing this experience with my wife is a real blessing. I'm averaging being involved directly in about two productions each season," he said. "Theater people are open, winsome, accepting and fun to be around."

He has found the theater experience to be challenging, too. For John, with a leg prothesis, mobility can be an issue when moving up and down set stairs and dancing. "Markus Baldwin, builds a railing into the set for me, and Julie Mitchell [Markus' wife and co-artistic director] is very supportive. They and the casts and crews I've worked with are great! However, having a



senior moment and forgetting a line is terrifying for me." Challenges aside, John said, "I've found I can still sing. Through being part of the theater life, I've made friends, and we keep in touch. We bond night after night while working together."

Before the advent of COVID, John volunteered in the community through Compassion Corsicana and by tutoring Corsicana ISD students. Also, he and Karen enjoyed hosting a Korean teacher in their home when the group of teachers came to Corsicana. "I like the arts community here," John said of his adopted Corsicana area. "but as a minister, I have experienced many areas of living here that needed improvement. I want to help meet those community needs through Nonviolent Navarro, lesus said, 'Follow me,' not, 'Worship me.' We are beginning a faith community to respond to spiritual hunger needs, and

help others in spiritual growth, teaching nonviolent perspectives and practices and meditation."

A native of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, John stated, "I grew up in a Presbyterian minister's home, and then I became one. Jesus has always been my example to follow." John graduated from Westminster College, earned his Master of Divinity through studies at Princeton Theological Seminary and earned a Doctor of Ministry at Columbia Theological Seminary in Decatur, Georgia. John was ordained as a Presbyterian minister in 1978. His career path has taken him to multiple locations and positions of service. "I was part of the Young Life staff and served as a youth minister, but those days are passed," he said jokingly in reference to his senior citizen status, "and I have served as a minister." He and Karen have seven children and four grandchildren between them.

When John began his research on nonviolence, he found a "treasure trove" in the United Nations International Day of Non-Violence, Mahatma Gandhi's teachings, Martin Luther King Jr.'s Six Principals of Nonviolence and Nonviolent Austin, after which he named Nonviolent Navarro. With a little help, he has set up a Facebook page for the group and is busy organizing it as a viable nonprofit. The group organized an event to celebrate the International Day of Nonviolence and hosted a Peace Concert in Corsicana in which national and local talents were featured. John is looking forward to the Season of Peace, sponsored by Campaign Nonviolence,

a project of Pace e Bene (September 21 to October 2). It promotes peace, dignity and equality on a healthy planet. He hopes to grow the group through social media contacts and more such events.

Inspired by Isaiah 2:4, Nonviolent Navarro seeks to turn "swords into plowshares ... nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore." John is firm in his beliefs. "Any conflict situation, at any level from family to nation, is possible to be resolved peacefully in a way that will be fair and benefit all parties. There's no such thing as redemptive violence, but there is redemptive suffering. Punitive justice can be changed to restorative justice."

As Gandhi once said, "The day the power of love overrules the love of power, the world will know peace." John, with peace in his own heart, continues to help others seeking that peace. **NOW**



Bobbye Hathcock enjoyed visiting her mother's Louisiana family often while raising her own five daughters. The getting-to-be-famous biscuits recipe that's part of Bobbye's Heart Attack Breakfast fixins' came from those times with her Aunt Clydie. "I always said it was her hands molding those biscuits that made hers the best!" Bobbye explained.

Born in Dallas and raised in Seattle, Washington, Bobbye started cooking in fourth grade. "I like recipes with five ingredients or less," she said, "but mostly I cook with no recipe." She creates dishes from leftovers.

Bobbye is known as "Honey" by her grandchildren. She and her husband, Ron, who is also a cook, love to host family (now numbering 24), as well as smaller gatherings for friends. She added, "When they love my breakfast, that's a win for me!" Now

Bobbye's Biscuits

Makes 22 biscuits.

6 cups Gold Medal Self-rising Flour, plus extra for coating biscuits
1/2 tsp. sea salt
1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/2 cup vegetable oil, plus extra for the skillet's bottom4 1/2 cups buttermilk

I. Preheat the oven to 425 F. In a large mixing bowl, mix the first 3 ingredients with a pastry cutter.

2. Add the vegetable oil; mix the batter with a large spoon. The batter will be very sticky.

3. Cover the bottom of a black iron skillet with vegetable oil; drop large serving spoon-size amounts of biscuit batter into a bowl filled with flour. Dust all sides of each biscuit; roll by hand into a ball.

4. Roll the biscuit in the skillet's oil before adding the biscuit to the skillet. The biscuits should be tight and touching each other.
5. Place the skillet into the oven; bake for 23-26 minutes until the biscuits are medium brown.

6. Remove the skillet from the oven; let the biscuits sit in the skillet for 5-10 minutes before serving.

Lemon Refrigerator Pie

- 1 8-oz. can frozen lemonade, thawed
- I 14-oz. can unsweetened condensed milk
- 1 8-oz. tub Cool Whip
- I graham cracker crust

 In a bowl, combine the lemonade with the condensed milk; fold in the Cool Whip.
 Pour the filling into a graham cracker crust; refrigerate for 2 hours until firm.

Peach Cobbler

stick butter
 15.25-oz. can sliced peaches
 cup self-rising flour
 cups sugar (divided use)
 cup milk
 Vanilla ice cream, to taste

In a baking dish, melt the butter; add the peaches, including the juice.
 In a bowl, mix the flour, I cup sugar and the milk; pour this mixture over the peaches. Sprinkle the other I cup of sugar over the top.

3. Bake at 350 F for 45 minutes, or until the cobbler is golden brown; serve with vanilla ice cream.

Strawberry Surprise

Note: This is delicious, and the onions are the surprise!

I cup onions, diced
I 1/2 cups sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
I/2 cup mayonnaise
I/2 to I cup strawberry preserves
Ritz Crackers, to taste

I. In a bowl, mix the onions, cheese and mayonnaise, adding more mayonnaise, if needed, to hold the mixture together when molded.

2. On a serving dish, mold the mixture into a circle around a middle opening. Fill the opening with the strawberry preserves. Serve on the Ritz Crackers.




