



# CHALLENGES AND VICTORIES

*He arrived three months early and spent his first 74 days on Earth in Hillcrest Hospital of Waco and Cook Children's Medical Center of Fort Worth. At a birth weight of 2 pounds, 11 ounces, Connor Chaney learned to fight for his life early. His journey has been one with ups and downs, and will continue to be so, but in May 2025, he graduated from Blooming Grove High School with a job offer in hand. Connor chooses a positive attitude when looking into the future. "I love the Bible verse, Jeremiah 29:11," he said quoting, "For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."*

Connor's childhood was full of school days and hospital stays, mostly at Cook Children's Medical Center in Fort Worth. Multiple surgeries and seizures have been major challenges. As a Corsicana resident, with parents, Richard and Nancy Chaney, Connor was a student in Corsicana ISD at Navarro Elementary through fourth grade. His middle school and senior high years have been spent in Blooming Grove ISD. "Having 'aged out' of Cook's, Connor now receives care through the neurology department at Tarrant County Neurology, which is associated with Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth," Nancy stated. "It was hard to leave Cook's. The staff were like family. However, through all the surgeries and seizures, Connor smiles. We have a prayer wall and graduation wall at home. The thoughts help us through tough days."

In typical fashion, Connor handles his current treatments in brain and nerve stimulation with a quip and smile, "I'm magnetic." Nancy agreed, "People do gravitate to him and want to meet him."

Richard and Nancy married when Connor was 7 years old. She adopted Connor when he was 11 years old, but Richard has been there throughout Connor's entire journey to give him piggyback rides and to take him hunting, fishing and RV camping.

A Navarro County Precinct 3 employee, Richard works with large equipment, and Connor has always loved the big movers



and haulers. "He knows big equipment," Richard explained. Connor likes to collect keys, fill up feeders and hunt hogs and deer. Last year, he brought down an 11-point buck from 50-yards away with a Mossberg Patriot 243.

At BG High School, Connor played the French horn in the marching band, and he's proud of his senior entry in the school's yearbook. He is proud of lettering in band, of his senior ring and taking the senior walk with his Senior Class and the students who will be the Class of 2037. He follows a heritage at BG set by his mom when she was a high school cheerleader and the homecoming queen. "Everyone in Blooming Grove has been there for Connor, aka CC," Nancy said.

With Mom at her Navarro College job and Dad at work, both parents worried throughout Connor's school days and lived with a phone. "The first words when we call each other are,

'Connor's OK,' then we can go on with, 'Now, can you pick up bread?' Nancy explained. 'This worry still continues

today, but God has held tightly onto each of us.' Her advice to other parents of medically challenged kids is, 'Hang onto each other and the Lord.'

Grandparents and the family's Northside Baptist Church family have been there to help, too. 'There's not enough time for me to tell how much that's meant to us,' Nancy reflected. Richard is a Northside deacon, and the family is active in the church's nursery and as church greeters. Connor was honored during the church's recent Senior Sunday.

"Pastor Daniel Harper is one of my mentors," Connor shared. Even though his life hasn't been easy, Connor empathizes with others. "I see people all over who are homeless with no family or a bed to sleep in and even going through similar struggles. I know that I am blessed."

As Connor approached graduation, Richard and Nancy were concerned about his future. Connor has been saving money for a tractor and loves to save Chick-Fil-A points, but they wondered about his job prospects since he isn't allowed to drive because of

his seizures. The answer came when, due to Connor's love of big machinery, the family visited Bobcat of Corsicana during the company's opening.

"The staff was impressed by 'that cool kid,' and asked Connor to come back the next week," Nancy recalled. "They gave him a tour, lots of gifts and a job as a Junior Brand Ambassador with his own signature skid steer series — the T86! With the job offer, Connor was celebrated by his fellow BG seniors with a signing day before graduation.

"We will take whatever the good Lord brings to Connor's future," Richard added.

With nearly always a smile that lights his countenance; a positive attitude; a sense of humor; an almost encyclopedic knowledge of numbers, dates, Scriptures and types of big equipment; Connor faces his daily medical challenges. "Another one of my favorite Scriptures is Psalm 18:2," he said, reciting it quickly. "The Lord is always with me. I've never asked, 'Why me?,' but I am ready to be seizure free. However, I know I'm not in control. God is." **NOW**

## Chicken Pasta Salad

Either grilled chicken or chicken cooked in a slow or pressure cooker can be used for this recipe. Serves 8.

### Dressing:

**1 cup mayonnaise**  
**1 cup coleslaw dressing**

### Pasta:

**1 12-oz. pkg. farfalle pasta, cooked according to pkg. instructions and drained**  
**1 20-oz. can pineapple chunks, drained**

**1 14-oz. can mandarin oranges, drained**  
**1 cup celery, chopped**  
**2 green onions, sliced**  
**1 cup red grapes**  
**3/4 cup dried cranberries**  
**1/2 cup cashews**  
**2 boneless skinless chicken breasts, cooked and diced**  
**Lettuce (optional)**

- 1. For the dressing:** In a bowl, mix the mayonnaise and coleslaw dressing; set aside.
- 2. For the pasta:** In another large bowl, add the pasta, pineapple, mandarin oranges,

celery, onions, grapes, cranberries, cashews and chicken.

- 3. Pour the dressing over the pasta salad; toss to coat. If desired, serve individual salads on green lettuce leaves.**

## Mexican Lasagna

**1 16-oz. box lasagna noodles**  
**1 lb. ground beef**  
**1 1-oz. pkg. taco seasoning**  
**1 8-oz. jar picante sauce**  
**1 16-oz. pkg. sharp cheddar cheese, shredded**

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 F**
- 2. In a saucepan, cook the noodles according to package instructions; set aside.**
- 3. In a skillet, brown the ground beef; drain. Add the taco seasoning and picante sauce; mix well.**
- 4. In a 9x12-inch baking dish, alternate layers of the meat sauce, pasta and cheese, beginning and ending with the meat sauce.**
- 5. Bake for 30 minutes.**

## Sweet Potato Stuff

**3 cups sweet potatoes, mashed**  
**1 cup sugar**  
**1/2 cup milk**  
**2 eggs**  
**3 Tbsp. flour**  
**1 tsp. vanilla**  
**1 tsp. cinnamon**

### Topping:

**1/3 cup self-rising flour**  
**1 cup nuts, chopped**  
**1/3 cup butter, melted**  
**1 cup coconut**  
**1 cup brown sugar**

- 1. In a blender or with a hand mixer, mix all the sweet potato ingredients together; pour the mixture into a baking dish.**
- 2. In another bowl, mix all the topping ingredients; cover the sweet potato mixture with the topping.**
- 3. Bake at 375 F for 25 minutes.**
