

For Mansfield Wind Symphony conductor Brian Merrill, the love for music has always been there. He cannot venture back far enough in his memory to recall a time when music was not a part of his life. "My mother was a great pianist, looking forward to a career as a concert pianist," Brian said. "But World War II broke out, and she married a navy pilot. That changed her course, but she still played the piano at home, and, of course, it was my first instrument as she started teaching me piano at age 4." Brian progressed through the clarinet to the trombone, but today, his focus is conducting and teaching. He's earned the full confidence of Bill Myers, who established The Mansfield Wind Symphony to be an all-volunteer organization of adult musicians who have the passion and ability to perform advanced wind band literature for people of all ages and backgrounds in the DFW area.


President, executive director and trombonist Lee Harbaugh was grateful for Brian's wholehearted leadership as the ensemble played, for the first time since the pandemic-produced delay, at the end-of-July Texas Bandmasters Association Convention in San Antonio. Next up, Mansfield Wind Symphony will be presenting a concert at Lake Ridge High School on Sunday, October 3 at 3:00 p.m. Like all of their concerts, it is free and open to the public. And in December, the ensemble will perform in Chicago at the international band and orchestra conference for music educators called The Midwest Clinic.

Performing its first concert in the fall of 2003, the Mansfield Wind Symphony is a true community and education partner. Though the band is comprised of amateur musicians from several surrounding cities, the practices and concerts are primarily performed in the city, and the symphony also supports the music education programs from the middle schools through the high schools.

"We have a number of band directors in the symphony, but we also have lawyers, accountants and IT specialists. Just about any vocation is represented. We offer the musicians the opportunity to keep playing, and the group finds it rewarding," Brian continued.

He never planned to pursue musical performance as a career, only wanting to teach. Growing up in Fort Worth with classical influences, Brian's parents took him to the Fort Worth Symphony and the Fort Worth Opera. "In the '60s and '70s, Pascal High School had a fantastic jazz program. That was also what attracted me to further my education at North Texas State University [now The University of North Texas]," he said. "They have a great music program and are known for

jazz." After a career directing bands in public schools in North Texas, Brian enjoyed 11 years as an adjunct professor at SMU, primarily teaching band directors who had, according to Brian, "spent enough time as band directors in public schools to know there was more to learn."

The Mansfield Wind Symphony has four primary local concerts each year, and smaller groups of the band may be called upon from time to time to perform at smaller events. For instance, Brian may be asked to provide a brass quintet for a Chamber of Commerce event. When the group traveled this July to San Antonio for the Texas Bandmasters Association Convention, the 77 participants were excited enough about making the trip to pay all of the expenses themselves. They received the music for the concert in June, and there were three practice sessions before the trip.

As soon as they returned from San Antonio, they began working on the music for their December performance at The Midwest Clinic. The ensemble was invited to the prestigious event in 2020, but then it was canceled because of the virus. According to Brian, the last time the wind symphony played together before the lockdown was February 11, 2020. That performance was videotaped and sent as part of the application for the invitation to The Midwest Clinic. Part of the emphasis at the clinic is to introduce and present music literature that has been written within the past two years. Brian said. "Of the nine selections we will play, six are from 2021. Also, selections will be played from various "grades" of music literature. Grades 1-3 are easier to

play and have more of an educational purpose. It is along the lines of what the middle school and junior high directors who attend the conference will be looking for. Literature graded 4-6 has a more artistic intent."

When Brian was named conductor of the Mansfield Wind Symphony almost five years ago, he pursued more challenging music. "Most of the members liked it, and it attracted some stronger musicians. Others in the group believe they improved their skills because of it," Brian recalled.

The wind symphony practices together three times before each event, and the rehearsals each last about two hours. "Most of our members have other vocations or family obligations. They have a good time at the rehearsals, and they come prepared because they have had the music to review and practice before our rehearsals are scheduled. No one comes to rehearsals to sight-read," Brian related with a smile.



The Mansfield Wind Symphony enjoys being part of the community, and provides music not only for the enjoyment of the community, but also music education opportunities. Each year the wind symphony has contests for students to write melodies from which a winning selection will be played by the wind symphony, and the student may get to conduct. Methodist Mansfield Medical Center also provides an annual scholarship for which students have the opportunity to compete.

Brian is looking forward to the future of the Mansfield Wind Symphony. It is obviously a labor of love for him and all of its musicians. NOW





If you're curious what's inside the huge, cube-shaped, concrete building near James McKnight Park, Brandon Hebert is expecting your call. As General Manager of FieldhouseUSA, it's Brandon's job to plug the community into his company's myriad athletic resources.

His one-stop shop for parents beautifully maintains eight futsal courts, 12 volleyball courts and eight basketball courts for youth and adults devoted to indoor team sports. FieldhouseUSA also leases space along the perimeter of its pristine, state-of-the-art,

air-conditioned facility to other fitness-oriented businesses offering alternative services and athletic opportunities. On weekends, they offer table space to entrepreneurs seeking exposure to the local and out-of-state families attending the jam-packed, indoor tournaments.

Brandon stays busy operating and managing FieldhouseUSA's year-round youth sports leagues for basketball, volleyball and futsal. "A super-popular sport in South America, and growing here, futsal is a skill-based, fast-paced, five-on-five soccer game played on our hardwood, 94-foot court," Brandon said.

After almost five years of service, Brandon's promotion to manage Mansfield's FieldhouseUSA facility came when the location was serving 1.9 million visitors, just before COVID-19 hit. This year, FieldhouseUSA is on target to serve 2 million people. Its growth is partly possible because Brandon delegates tasks to FieldhouseUSA's outsourced event planner, Bailey Hebert.

As little sister to Brandon, she tagged along with the family to all his sports tournaments. Their incredible friendship translates into a superbly effective indoor sports facility in service to the community. "Bailey does a great job of finding outside events that need a big space," her brother said. "We've hosted dog shows, boxing matches, gymnastics, pickleball and cornhole tournaments and vendor fairs."

This winter, the duo is throwing their inaugural SneakerBallTX, a charitable New Year's Eve celebration for adults. Formal attire is required. Guests are invited to walk the red carpet onto the hardwood floors, provided they pair their suits and ties, dresses and jewelry with sneakers.

"Heels and dress shoes definitely mess up hardwood floors," Bailey said. Otherwise, the evening will involve everything you'd expect in a casino night, plus heavy hors d'oeuvres and a champagne toast when the balloons drop at midnight. In addition, SneakerBallTX's silent auction benefits the Mansfield ISD Education Foundation in support of the essentials that taxpayer dollars won't fund.

"We want to give back and do something for the parents who spend so much time in here giving of themselves for their kids," Brandon said. "This event provides the parents with a great night out while their dollars spent for relaxation are funneled straight back into the youth."

At the same time, FieldhouseUSA will host an event called Dallas Kickspo to raise funds for Kicks 4 the City, a nonprofit focusing on providing lightly used athletic apparel, new socks, sneakers and shoes for youth. Children and adults are invited to this big vendor fair on the day before and morning of SneakerBallTX. "We designed this for families to learn about local vendors who don't yet have a big platform," Bailey said.

Private clients are also welcome to contact Brandon to arrange prescheduled camps, clinics and trainings in hours not open to the public. If you're curious to see another side of FieldhouseUSA, dive in deeper with SneakerBallTX. But always, you are welcome to enjoy great activities at FieldhouseUSA year-round. NOW







# Roasted Lemon-Pepper Chicken With Herbs

2-4 chicken breast cutlets 2 tsp. olive oil Salt, to taste Pepper, to taste 2 tsp. lemon pepper 1 lemon, halved and zested 2 cloves garlic, minced 2 fresh rosemary sprigs

2 fresh theme spri

2 fresh thyme sprigs

2 tsp. unsalted butter, softened

**I.** Wash and pat the chicken dry.

**2.** Add the oil to the chicken breasts while coating them evenly.

3. Season the chicken with salt, pepper,

lemon pepper, lemon juice with zest and minced garlic. Let stand at room temperature for 20 minutes before roasting.

- **4.** Preheat the oven to 425 F. Wash, dry and strip the rosemary and thyme sprigs; chop the leaves. In a small bowl, mash the butter with the chopped herbs.
- **5.** Using a spoon, scoop some of the herbed butter onto the chicken breasts.
- **6.** Set a rack in a large roasting pan. Put the chicken on the rack; roast for 25-40 minutes, or until the chicken is golden brown and a thermometer inserted into the thickest part of the meat reaches 165 F.

# "Clouds of Heaven" Mashed Potatoes

5 lbs. russet potatoes, peeled and medium diced

32 oz. cold water

2-3 tsp. salt (divided use)

8 Tbsp. unsalted butter, cubed

I cup heavy cream
I/4 cup sour cream
I tsp. fresh chives, chopped (optional)
Pepper, to taste

- **1.** Place the potatoes in a large soup pot. Cover with cold water; add 1 tsp. salt to the water. Bring to a boil over high heat; cook until the potatoes are fork-tender (18-22 minutes).
- **2.** Drain the potatoes; place into a large bowl. Set aside.
- **3.** Heat the butter and cream in a small pot over low heat; bring to a simmer. Pour the cream mixture over the potatoes; stir until combined.
- **4.** Add the sour cream and chopped chives; combine with a hand mixer or whisk until potatoes are light and fluffy. Fold in more salt and cracked black pepper, to taste.

# Brussels Sprouts With Smoked Maple Dry Rub Seasoning

16 oz. Brussels sprouts, quartered and blanched

16 oz. cold water

- I Tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil (to coat sprouts)
- 2 cloves garlic, minced

Salt, to taste

Pepper, to taste

- 2 Tbsp. McCormick's Smoked Maple Dry Rub Seasoning
- **I.** Preheat the oven to 400 F. Trim the ends of the Brussels sprouts; slice into halves. Discard any tough or discolored outer leaves. Rinse in a large bowl of water.
- **2.** Blanch the Brussels sprouts; pat each dry. Transfer them to a nonstick baking sheet. Note: you can use Parchment paper for ease of cleanup.
- **3.** Drizzle the Brussels sprouts with oil; toss them with the seasonings until evenly coated.
- **4.** Roast for 20-35 minutes until dark brown, but not burned. Shake or rotate the pan every 10 minutes until evenly cooked.

# No-Bake Cheesecake With Amaretto Whipped Cream

### Cheesecake:

- 2 8-oz. pkgs. cream cheese, softened
- 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar (divided use)
- 2 cups heavy whipping cream (divided use)
- 2 pkgs. gelatin or agar powder
- 3 oz. water
- 2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1 graham cracker crust





### Whipped Topping:

- 1 Tbsp. amaretto liqueur
- 1 9-inch graham cracker crust

### Garnish:

### 1 cup fresh strawberries, sliced

- **1.** For cheesecake: In a stand mixer, whip the cream cheese until it is smooth. Add 1 cup sugar and 1 cup heavy whipping cream; whip on medium speed for 3-5 minutes.
- 2. Prepare the gelatin as directed on the



package by dissolving the gelatin in 3 oz. of water that has been heated in the microwave for 3 minutes. Pour the gelatin in a slow, steady stream into the cream cheese mixture while the mixer is stirring on low speed. Once combined, add the vanilla extract.

- **3.** Pour the mixture into a pre-made graham cracker crust; refrigerate, covered, for 4 hours or overnight.
- **4.** For whipped topping: Combine the remaining cream and sugar with the liqueur. Whip into soft peaks. Use as a topping for the cheesecake with fresh berries as a garnish.

# Pan-Seared Salmon With Honey Garlic Glaze

- 4 6-oz. salmon fillets
- I Tbsp. salt mixed with I Tbsp. cracked black pepper (divided use)

### Glaze:

- 1/3 cup honey
- 1/4 cup unsalted butter, melted
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- I tsp. red pepper flakes
- 3 Tbsp. vegetable oil (divided use)

### Garnish:

1/2 cup microgreens (optional) 1 lemon, sliced thinly (optional)

- **1.** Wash and pat dry the salmon fillets. Sprinkle each with half of the salt and pepper mixture; set aside.
- **2.** For glaze: In a medium bowl, whisk together the honey, melted butter, garlic and red pepper flakes, along with the remaining salt and pepper mixture; set aside.
- **3.** Heat 2 Tbsp. oil in a large iron skillet over medium-high temperature. When the oil is hot but not smoking, add the salmon to the pan. Cook salmon until deeply golden, about 6 minutes. Flip the salmon over; add the remaining oil.
- **4.** Brush or pour the honey-garlic glaze on top of each salmon fillet.
- **5.** Just before serving, garnish with microgreens or lemon slices, or both.



# Where Dinosaurs Trod

— By Lisa Bell

Heading south, a short drive leads to Glen Rose. Near the intersection of Texas highways 67 and 144, prepare for more than expected when visiting this community. Known as the Dinosaur Capital of Texas, you can't visit without reminders of the beloved beasts.

Dinosaur Valley State Park offers a well-known place to see tracks. While splashing in the river within the park, you might stand in the middle of one. Several areas feature giant footprints, cast forever in the Paluxy River bed. DVSP only begins the adventure.

The Creation Evidence Museum of Texas also displays

dinosaur and human prints besides other interesting archeological finds. Annually, the museum offers a public excavation of tracks, a memorable hands-on paleontological experience. The McFall Mountain Dinosaur Tracks, also managed by the museum, boasts the longest continuous set of tracks.

Dinosaur World's dominant feature consists of a 1-mile trail with more than 150 life-size dinosaur replicas. Admission includes a fossil dig site for kids, a museum and more.

To continue, visit the Somervell County Museum. One room contains a wall mural of a 1954 *National Geographic* article about track excavations and mammoth bones found in the area.

For those who love history more than the beasts, the museum has amazing displays, from war heroes to local history.

The museum dedicated one wall display to John St. Helen who claimed his identity as John Wilkes Booth. Yes, the infamous Booth who assassinated Lincoln. The display includes an authorized biography by Finis L. Bates and a derringer found behind St. Helen's log cabin. The cabin now resides in the downtown area.

While visiting, be sure to venture to Bernard's Mill. Now an art museum, the building itself tells a story. Immense rooms contain limestone walls and massive beams. Filled with art, it makes a great place to spend several hours. Built in 1890, it once served as the hospital. Nurses lived on the upper floor, which still depicts their daily life.

Looking to get outside? On warm days, enjoy the coolness of the Paluxy River in and around DVSP or at Big Rocks Park. When the water becomes too chilly, families still enjoy climbing over the enormous rocks or strolling along the Glen Rose Riverwalk, a lighted, paved walkway that runs beside the river. Plus, the state park includes miles of hiking, biking and even equestrian trails.

While there, don't forget Fossil Rim Wildlife Center. The safe way to experience the thrill of a safari has many options. Many of their resident animals appear on the endangered species list, the center striving to save them.

You can always visit the amphitheater to see *The Promise* in fall months. Check out the Somervell Expo Center for a wide variety of events and time your visit for one of those.

With a vast assortment of restaurants, finding cuisine to fit your tastes doesn't take long. At Storiebook Café, you can browse and read books while enjoying food. At Sexton's Feed Company, enjoy a view of the river while dining. Then, partake in a fun activity such as axe throwing, cornhole, live music, pool and an arcade room.

With a choice of hotels, bed-and-breakfast locations, cabins and multiple RV parks, you can spend days enjoying the history and adventure of Glen Rose. When you leave, you can say, "I walked where dinosaurs trod."


