





# EVERYTHICS ECOLORISE

With passion for the grace, beauty, power and spirit of the horse, Stephanie and Sadie Ford, a mother and daughter duo, are artists who paint and compete in model horse shows. Sadie is also taking after her mother by learning to ride and compete with a favorite lesson pony in equestrian events. "Horses are a lot of fun to work with because it's like they can almost understand you," Sadie explained. "You learn a lot, such as patience, hard work and to be gentle with them. With model horses, I get to learn about different breeds, colors and patterns."

"I moved around a lot as a child, but my parents always allowed me to ride," Stephanie recalled. "Riding was something that kept me stable — no pun intended — through a difficult time of never being able to keep friends

due to constant moves all over the country. I think horses are very healthy for young people to be involved with. They teach so many lessons, including delayed gratification after a lot of hard work. They are also unique, each with their own quirks, and it takes patience and kindness to build a working relationship with a horse and become a team that can enter a show ring."

Sadie's interest in horses inspired Stephanie to return to a hobby she enjoyed in high school and college — painting and competing in shows with model horses. They compete, regionally for now, through the North American Model Horse Shows Association. Points earned allow the artist to show at the national level in Lexington, Kentucky, followed by BreyerFest, where attendees get to see live horses who model for the sculptures. "I went in the 1990s, and William Shatner and his Saddlebreds were guests. I hope to take Sadie one day," Stephanie said.

"I've been riding horses for almost three years," Sadie stated. "My favorite breed is Pony of the Americas, but I also like Paint horses, and I think Arabians are beautiful, tough and have an interesting history. I've been showing model horses for a year, though I've collected about 100 Schleich horses since kindergarten, and I'm starting to collect Breyer horses.

"The model horse shows are very busy," Sadie continued. "There are classes for adults and youth. The judges are



nice and helpful. They stop to teach about competitors' choices and how the horse models are presented. I really like to paint models. It's fun to create my own, and I learn about different horse breeds."

There are also classes for novices in the age groups. "Sadie's just starting out with acrylics, but model horse artists will resculpt using epoxy, and then paint the models using an airbrush, pan pastels, acrylics and oils," Stephanie explained. Stephanie is an artist and teacher and instructs Sadie in this shared hobby.

Sadie intertwines what she learns from riding horses with her hobby of painting them. "I like the performance classes in model horse showing," she said. "I use real patterns that I had to do in past shows with real horses, such as trail or horsemanship, even if the doll riders won't hold the reins perfectly. I was excited to get Youth Performance Champion last April, and I was awarded



a hand-painted model with a driving harness." Sadie sometimes uses the horses she's ridden as inspiration for her art. "My favorite model horse is one my mom gave me for Christmas that she painted to look like Freckles."

Freckles can be found at Flying Dollar Ranch where Sadie takes lessons from ranch manager, Julie Hinz, who also volunteers with 4-H. "My favorite memory is horse camp. At the end of camp, we do a drill team performance," Sadie shared. "I ride several horses there, but I show Freckles in English riding, Western riding and do games. Freckles is a fun mare. At one show Freckles, age 23, surprised everyone by winning most of the games."

"Sadie has full support from her family, including me; my husband and Sadie's dad, Bradley; and both sets of grandparents, who attend her events and help with some of the financial costs," Stephanie said.

"I appreciate my dad, who puts up with all the model horses around the house and takes me to riding lessons and shows," Sadie said. "He planned a trip to the World Equestrian Center




in Ocala, Florida, during this past summer's vacation, and he's not that crazy about horses."

A seventh-grader at Blooming Grove Jr. High, Sadie's favorite classes are band, in which she plays flute, and English. She loves to read and create stories and is looking forward to UIL cross-country and track. "I really like learning new music and going to band competitions," she stated. She's also a member of Blooming Grove First Baptist Church and volunteers with Kids for Christ there.


As a fifth-generation farmer on her

dad's family land, Sadie works with other animals, too. "I've kept sheep for four years," she said. "I started with a show lamb and used the money I got from him at the Navarro County Expo to buy breeding ewes. I raise Dorper sheep and have a livestock guardian dog, Thor, that I raised from a puppy and trained." Additionally, she has another dog, two cats and chickens. "I take care of the animals in the evenings, and any schoolwork I have, I try to get done at school, sometimes in my mom's classroom right after school's out. Good grades are a must, since her goal is to become a large animal veterinarian who works with horses and cattle. Sadie is a member of Silver Spurs 4-H Club through which she does volunteer work.

Stephanie treasures sharing her love and knowledge of art and horses with her daughter. Patience is needed, whether painting horses or building a relationship with a special real horse like Freckles. "Kindness and training go into riding horses," Stephanie shared. "It's these things which convinced my husband and I to support Sadie's passion." NOW



A car pulling to the right or left when the driver is steering forward not only makes driving a more arduous adventure, but it also causes uneven wear on tires and possibly poorer gas milage. Misalignment can also affect braking of the vehicle. "We're honest with every customer, and we want to make sure their vehicles are safe to drive," Jody Hoover, Alignment King's manager, stated. "Our service always starts with great communication with the customer."

Alignment King offers same day service and free Wi-Fi in the waiting room while techs perform alignment, brake and/or front end work or repair/replace tie rods, ball joints, shocks, struts and suspensions. "We use Bilstein shocks and O'Reilly and Monroe brakes," Jody explained. "O'Reilly and AutoZone are our main suppliers, who back up any part we put on a vehicle. Our warranty states we'll do what is needed to make sure the alignment stays good."

Hunter Hawkeye Elite Alignment technology is used to diagnose problems and even gives Jody and the techs the parts numbers to order. "The data will break repairs down to what is most important, so customers can prioritize the most needed parts if funds are tight. All the estimates are computer generated and in writing, and we talk to the customer first before adding any additional repairs," Jody explained.

The company is owned by Stephen Hoover and Josh Turner and has been managed by Jody for the past six years. "I've worked in the auto repair business almost 40 years and have been doing alignments for the past 12 years," Jody stated. "This is what I'm comfortable doing, and I've

been doing it all my life. Experience always helps in any profession. I enjoy talking to people and answering their questions, and I know how to train the new techs wanting to go into this as a career. I teach the guys to think outside the box, but they also must feel what they're doing when training and not just depend on high tech. We keep things simple to keep things rolling, and we pride ourselves on keeping a clean, organized shop. I'm still learning myself, as technology changes rapidly."

#### **Squash Casserole**

- 3-4 yellow squash, cut into bite-size pieces
- 1/4 cup onion, finely chopped Salt, to taste
- Velveeta cheese, to taste, cubed into small pieces

### Ritz Crackers, finely crushed 1/2 stick Bluebonnet Butter, melted (May use butter of your choice.)

**1.** In a large pot, cover the squash and onions with water. Add the salt; boil the vegetables until the squash is tender enough to mash. Drain well.

- **2.** In a bowl, mash the squash/onion mixture with a fork. Add the cheese; stir gently until the cheese is melted.
- **3.** Pour the mixture into a greased casserole dish; top with the Ritz Crackers.
- **4.** Spoon the butter over the crackers; bake at 350 F for 20-30 minutes, or until the top is lightly browned

#### Sausage Pinwheels

- 1 8-count can crescent rolls
- 1 lb. ground sausage
- 1 8-oz. pkg. cheddar cheese, shredded
- **1.** Preheat the oven to 375 F. Spread the Crescent Rolls flat onto waxed paper; press the seams out smoothly, so the rolls become a large rectangle of dough.
- **2.** Spread the sausage evenly onto the dough; top with the cheese.
- **3.** Roll from the long side of the rectangle to create one long roll; wrap it in Saran Wrap or another plastic wrap.
- **4.** Put the roll into the freezer for 30 minutes or more. Remove the roll from

the freezer; slice the roll into pinwheels of desired thickness.

**5.** Place the pinwheels flat on a cookie sheet; bake for 15-20 minutes, or until golden brown and the meat is thoroughly cooked.

#### **Homemade Hamburger Helper**

- 1 lb. ground meat
- I bell pepper, or to taste, chopped
- I onion, or to taste, chopped
- 1 10-oz. can Ro-Tel tomatoes
- 1 8-oz, can tomato sauce
- 1 7.25-oz. box macaroni and cheese, prepared according to package instructions

#### Cheddar cheese, to taste, grated

- **I.** In a skillet, brown the ground meat, bell peppers and onions. Add the Ro-Tel and tomato sauce.
- 2. Stir well; cook about 10 minutes until the mixture is thoroughly heated.
- **3.** Add the prepared macaroni and cheese to the meat mixture. Pour the hamburger helper into a casserole dish; top with the cheddar cheese.
- 4. Bake at 350 F until the hamburger helper is bubbly and the cheese is melted.

#### Sugar Cookies

- 1 cup Crisco
- $1 \, 1/2$  cups sugar, plus additional for topping each cookie
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp. orange juice (optional)
- I tsp. orange zest (optional)
- 3 cups flour
- 2 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. salt
- Butter
- **1.** In a bowl, cream the Crisco and  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ cups sugar. Add the vanilla, eggs and orange juice and orange zest, if using; mix well.
- 2. Add the flour, baking powder and salt; mix well.
- 3. Drop the dough by teaspoonfuls onto a lightly greased cookie sheet.
- 4. Butter the bottom of a glass, dip in sugar; use the glass to press each cookie down flatter.
- 5. Bake at 375 F for 10-12 minutes; cool on a cooling rack before serving.
